6 AND GIVING NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A
7 MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION THEREFOR
8 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 18 OF THE DISTRICT ACT
9 AND THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

10 WHEREAS, this Board intends to undertake a project in Riverside County, within the
11 unincorporated community of Menifee, designated as the Menifee-Hawthorne Avenue Storm Drain, Stage
12 1; and

13 WHEREAS, the proposed project is bounded generally by Newport Road to the north, Craig
14 Avenue to the south, Geary Street to the east, and Byers Street to the west; and

15 WHEREAS, the proposed project consists of the construction and subsequent operation and
16 maintenance of approximately 5,130 lineal feet of an underground storm drain system; and

17 WHEREAS, reference is made to the engineering estimate of the cost of the proposed project,
18 entitled "Engineer's Statement" on file with the Clerk of this Board; and

19 WHEREAS, reference is made to a map dated June 2007, bearing the name and showing the
20 general location and typical section of the proposed project which is also on file with the Clerk of the
21 Board; and

22 WHEREAS, the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the District has found that the proposed
23 project will not have a significant effect on the environment and has prepared a Mitigated Negative
24 Declaration which will not become final until adopted by this Board; and

25 WHEREAS, any person wishing to comment on the proposed project or the Mitigated Negative
26 Declaration may do so in writing between the date of this notice and the public hearing, or may appear
27 and be heard at the time and place noted below; and

28 WHEREAS, in a subsequent legal challenge any person may be limited to raising only those
issues he, she or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written comments

1 delivered before or at the public hearing; and

2 WHEREAS, prior to making a decision on the proposed project or the Mitigated Negative
3 Declaration, this Board will consider all written and oral comments; and

4 WHEREAS, the above-listed documents can be inspected at the District office, 1995 Market
5 Street, Riverside, California 92501 and written comments will be received at the above address.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
7 Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session
8 assembled on January 29, 2008 that:

9 1. A public hearing concerning the proposed project and the Mitigated Negative Declaration
10 will be held at 1:30 p.m. on March 11, 2008, at the meeting room of this Board, 1st Floor, County
11 Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at which time all public comment shall
12 be heard.

13 2. A copy of this resolution and copies of the above-listed documents shall be posted at least 30
14 days before said hearing at the Canyon Lake Branch Library, 31516 Railroad Canyon Road, Canyon
15 Lake, California 92587.

16 3. A copy of this resolution shall be posted at least 30 days before said hearing at the Riverside
17 County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, California 92507.

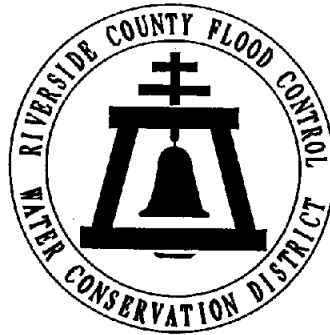
18 4. The Clerk of this Board is directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published twice,

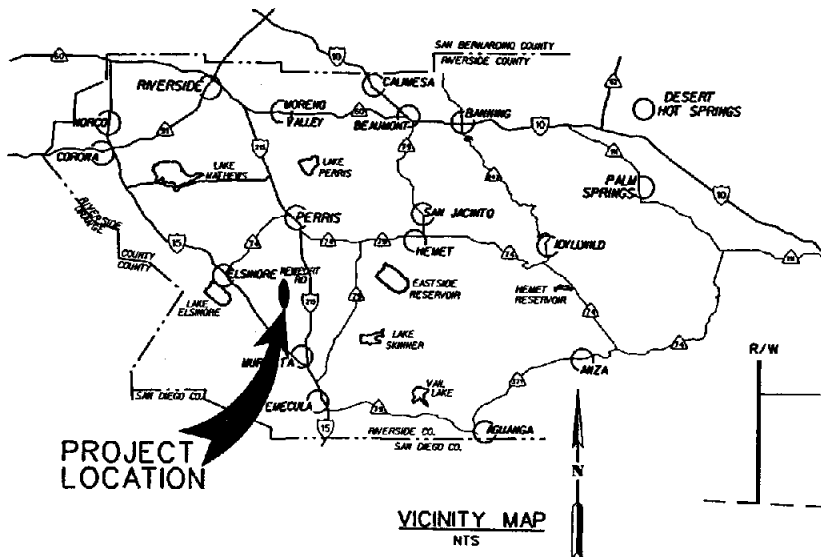
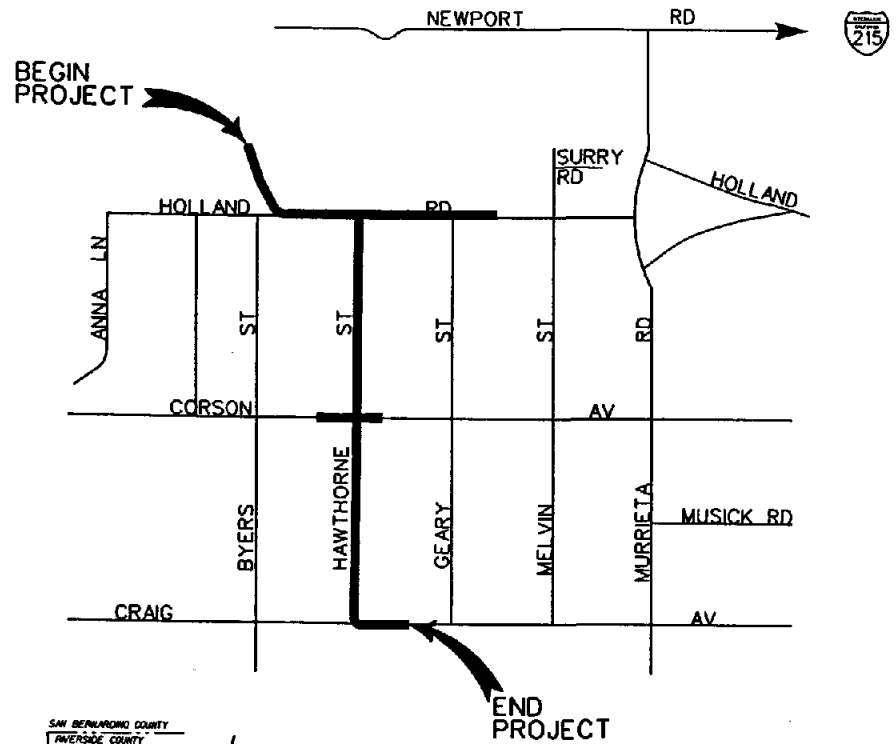

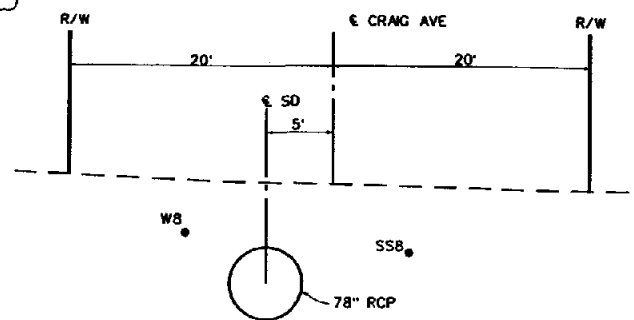
SECTION 18

Menifee – Hawthorne Avenue Storm Drain, Stage 1

Engineer's Statement

This proposed project is located within the unincorporated community of Menifee, Riverside County, California. The project is an ultimate storm drain system designed to collect runoff from a 400-acre watershed located southerly of Craig Avenue and convey it to the watershed located at the northeasterly corner of Holland Road and Byers Street. When complete, this storm drain will provide 100-year flood protection.

The main line of the proposed project consists of approximately 3,840 lineal feet of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) ranging in diameter from 66 to 78 inches. The laterals consist of approximately 1,290 lineal feet of RCP ranging in diameter from 18 to 24 inches. From the outlet, the main line extends east in Holland Road, south in Hawthorne Street and ends approximately 300 feet east in Craig Avenue. One lateral will connect to the main line at the intersection of Holland Road and Hawthorne Street and will extend approximately 900 feet east in Holland Road. In addition, two laterals will connect to the main line at the intersection of Corson Avenue and Hawthorne Street, with one lateral extending east approximately 150 feet and one lateral extending west approximately 240 feet. The cost of the proposed project is approximately \$2,500,000.
