BACKGROUND:

The Waste Management Department (WMD) requires guard service at three (3) sites – Badlands Sanitary Landfill, Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill, and the Moreno Valley Headquarters buildings for Waste Management Department with all services performed during non-operating hours.

The security firm of Wackenhut Corporation was awarded the contract in August 2006. Wackenhut has terminated their agreement with WMD (letter attached). Because of Wackenhut's termination notice, WMD had to bring in the next lowest responsive/responsible bidder, General Security, Inc.

With Purchasing Department's approval, WMD requested pricing from the following two (2) firms – General Security Services and International Services, who ranked number two and three from the initial bid evaluation conducted in June 2006. General Security Services submitted current pricing of \$16.13 non-vehicle rate per hour totaling \$109,207 and \$18.54 vehicle bill rate totaling \$198,575, which equals \$307,782 for the three sites for one year at which time the services will be re-bid. International Services provided no response. In order to provide security coverage during the contract negotiation period, Central Purchasing authorized a short-term agreement with General Security Services, which expired in November 2007. The ending of the

WMD is requesting a total amount of \$310,000, which should be sufficient to cover the regular, required services and any emergency requests for guard services (e.g. Esperanza fire coverage) or special events where additional coverage may be needed.
