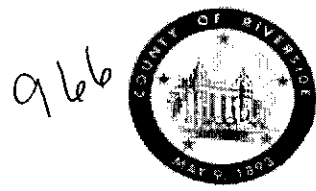

**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT RENEWAL GRANT AGREEMENT—  
U.S. VETERANS INITIATIVE (HU 3071-00 07/08)**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors ratify and:

1. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Grant Agreement between DPSS and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the attached U.S. Veterans Initiative Supportive Services Only (SSO) Grant for \$249,900 for the period of October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008;
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached contract HU 3272-00, between DPSS and the U.S. Veterans Initiative;
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments with the U.S. Veterans Initiative, not to exceed the maximum amount of the Grant Agreement (\$249,900); and
4. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the agreement with the U.S. Veterans Initiative.

**SUBJECT:** HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—  
U.S. VETERANS INITIATIVE

**BACKGROUND:**

On May 16, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.18), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Veterans In Progress (VIP) renewal project operated through a contract between U.S. Veterans Initiative and DPSS to provide supportive services to homeless veterans.

U.S. Veterans Initiative has served 50 homeless veterans under the previous one-year grant which ended on September 30, 2007. Under the renewal grant, U.S. Vets will continue with its goal of serving 50 homeless veterans.

There was a delay with HUD executing the attached renewal Grant Agreement due to modifications to the original application submitted. Due to HUD's late execution, this Agreement is being presented to the Board for approval retroactively to October 1, 2007.
