
SUBJECT: RESOLUTION #2008-140

4 RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY BILL 1858
5 RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES

6 Whereas, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors supports Assembly Bill 1858,
7 introduced by Assembly Member Jeffries, an act to amend Sections 1243, 20343, 31563, and
8 45310.3 of the Government Code, relating to public employees; and

9 Whereas, existing law requires an elected public officer, as defined, who takes office
10 or is reelected to office on or after January 1, 2006, to forfeit specified retirement benefits that
11 accrue during his or her term of office if he or she is convicted of any of certain felonies arising
12 out of his official duties, unless the governing body authorizes the public officer to receive
13 those benefits; and

14 Whereas, existing law provides that any contributions made by the elected public
15 officer that arose directly from or accrued solely as a result of his or her forfeited service as an
16 elected public officer shall be returned, as specified; and

17 Whereas, this bill would provide that these provisions shall apply to a public employee,
18 as defined, who is first hired on or after January 1, 2009, who is convicted of those specified
19 felonies arising directly out of his or her official duties as a public employee.
