


SUBJECT: Ordinance 877, An Ordinance of the County of Riverside establishing a recording fee under the Social Security Truncation Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Introduce Ordinance 877, and set for public hearing on Feb. 26, 2008 at 9:30 a.m.;
- 2) Adopt Resolution 2008-093, Resolution of the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorizing the County Recorder to charge an additional fee for implementation and ongoing operation of the Social Security Truncation Program and to require the Auditor-Controller to conduct reviews;
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to set the public hearing to Government Code 6062a; and
- 4) At the conclusion of the public hearing, adopt County Ordinance 877.

BACKGROUND: Assembly Bill 1168, which included the Social Security Number Truncation Program (SSNTP), was approved on October 13, 2007 to protect against the risk of identity theft. The SSNTP requires the County Recorder, beginning on or after January 1, 2009 and for each official record recorded on or after January 1, 1980, to create a copy of the official record, in an electronic format, by truncating any social security number contained in that official record. The truncated copy that is created is called the public record version. Once the public record version has been created, it will replace the official record version that is currently open for public inspection. The adoption of Resolution 2008-093 and County Ordinance 877 would allow for the county Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder to begin collecting \$1.00 for the recording of the first page of every instrument, paper, or notice that is recorded by the County of Riverside. This additional recording fee is needed to fund the SSNTP. Additionally, the Auditor-Controller is required to conduct two reviews to verify that the funds generated by the fee are used only for the purpose of the SSNTP.




