

SUBJECT: : Advisory Council Members appointment

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve appointment of the following member to the Riverside County Advisory Council on Aging.

BACKGROUND: The Advisory Council on Aging is a volunteer leadership body mandated under both the Older American's Act and the Older Californian's Act. Advisory Council members are appointed to serve in an advisory capacity to the Office on Aging and to the Board of Supervisors. The Council is comprised of 17 volunteer leaders. 
