SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to the Master Ambulance Agreement #04-038 with American Medical Response (AMR) for emergency ambulance service.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Second Amendment to the Master Agreement with AMR for the placement of an ambulance at Casino Morongo in the amount of \$90,000 for Fiscal Year 2007/2008;
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute future amendments with Casino Morongo; and
- 3) Authorize the Chairperson to execute the attached Amendment on behalf of the County

BACKGROUND: On November 27, 2007, Item 3.4, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC) grant awards. As part of two awards, the Riverside County EMS Agency will receive \$100,000 for fiscal year 2007/2008 for the placement of an ambulance in the PASS/Morongo reservation area to compensate for the increased 911 EMS calls created by Indian gaming activities. This Agreement will ensure that the Casino's impact on ambulance response times to the Banning/Beaumont pass area is mitigated.
