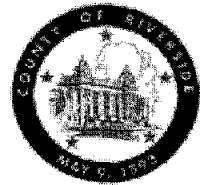

SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH

BACKGROUND:

On May 16, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.18), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Women's Supportive Housing Program, operated through a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Mental Health and DPSS to provide permanent housing for women with mental illness. The Department of Mental Health's goal is to serve 6 women.

While the original project ended on November 30, 2007, there was a delay with HUD executing the attached renewal Grant Agreement due to modifications to the original application submitted. Due to HUD's late execution, this Agreement is being presented to the Board for approval retroactively to December 1, 2007.
