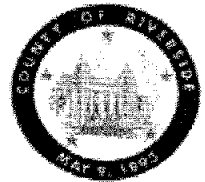

**SUBJECT:** Contract Award for the Construction of the Landfill Gas Flare Enclosure at the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill


**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept the bid submitted by Trinity Construction in the amount of \$155,718.00 for the Construction of the Landfill Gas Flare Enclosure at the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill; and
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Department.

**BACKGROUND:** The Board authorized the Department to advertise for bids on November 20, 2007. On January 15, 2008 the Department opened bids for the Construction of the Landfill Gas Flare Enclosure at the Edom Hill Sanitary Landfill. The Department received six bids ranging from \$155,718 to \$229,000. The engineer's estimate for this project is \$152,097. Trinity Construction submitted the lowest bid of \$155,718. The Department has determined that Trinity Construction has the necessary experience and capability to perform this project in accordance with the contract documents. County Counsel has determined that the bid documents are in order.
