Inspection - District II

The proposals were reviewed and ranked by a Selection Committee of four knowledgeable County employees. Interviews were held with three firms. The firms were separately ranked on the basis of the interviews. The firm with the highest ranking was Dudek Engineering & Environmental.

The total contract amount of \$271,700 is a not-to-exceed figure. The fees for this project will be billed on an hourly basis. It is anticipated that the project will take 12 months and that Dudek Engineering & Environmental will bill up to \$22,641 a month.

The Office of County Counsel has reviewed and approved the agreement for Project Management Services as to legal form.
