3. Approve and direct the Auditor Controller to make the budget adjustments as outlined in the attached schedule A.

The Riverside County Sheriff's Department, County Probation Department and the District Attorney's Office have been awarded funds for the second year of a project aimed at reducing the PC-290 non-compliance rate with the County of Riverside, as well as targeting predators who entice victims using the internet.

Penal Code section 290 requires sexual offenders to register with their local law enforcement agencies. Megan's Law generally makes registration information available to the public via law enforcement agencies and the internet. As of April 2007, approximately 472 of 3,395 sexual offenders were out of compliance with PC 290 in Riverside County, according to California Department of Justice (DOJ) statistics. The SAFE Team was able to clear 387 non-compliant registrants and increase the compliance rate to 90.5% by December 31, 2007. The OES funding will enable the SAFE Team to be fully operational and fully equipped with the ability to enhance its public education campaign, increase registration compliance and to take action against sexual offenders.

Law enforcement officials throughout Riverside County have identified a growing need for more aggressive efforts dedicated to identifying, monitoring, and arresting Penal Code (PC) section 290 registrants and sexual offenders in our county. The Riverside County SAFE Team is comprised of 50 members from Department of Justice, the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, District Attorney's Office, County Probation, and local police agencies. By educating the public on Megan's Law, engaging a S.P.I.D.E.R. (Sexual Predator Internet Decoy Enforcement in Riverside) unit, and conducting compliance sweeps, the Riverside County SAFE Team will have a local and regional impact by reducing the non-compliance rate.

The SAFE Team will continue to focus on activities such as non-compliance sweeps, the S.P.I.D.E.R. units' internet surveillance sting operation, coordination with SART (Sexual Assault Response Team) and the public education campaign. The Team committed to conduct five compliance sweeps prior to December 31, 2007. In fact, the Team conducted thirteen (13) compliance sweeps and each sweep covered a geographical area of Riverside County, corresponding to one of the five regional enforcement teams ensuring that all areas of Riverside County were covered. The S.P.I.D.E.R. unit is dedicated to conducting undercover internet sting operations aimed at sexual predators who seek to victimize children on the internet. The SART Team will work closely with sworn peace officers to assist in the forensic evaluation, treatment, and interviews of sexual assault victims and the investigation of sexual assault crimes.

The public education campaign is structured to achieve three main goals – (1) to increase public awareness of the basic content of Megan’s Law; (2) to inform the public how they can access sexual offender registration information; and (3) to teach the public how they can protect themselves and their families from sexual predators and sexual assault.

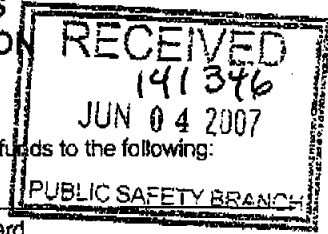
