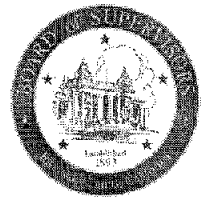

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

BACKGROUND: The Justin Hunt Memorial Trail is named after a Marine from Wildomar, California who gave his life for his country. The memorial trail is 1 ¼ miles long and will have two staging areas one at Gruwell Street and one at Penrose Street. The monuments will be 5' H. X 44" W. tan color with and antique sand finish.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$2,000 to support monuments for the marking of the Justin Hunt Memorial Trail.
