
BACKGROUND:

In the February 28, 2008 meeting of the Salton Sea Authority, the Board of Directors reviewed the restructuring of the organization and ongoing need for the Authority to maintain its role as a representative of the member agencies and to be the local voice in matters with the state and federal governments. The Authority's Board of Directors remains committed to restoration of the Salton Sea and participation in the State and Federal legislative process. A part of the Board's commitment was the approval of a supplemental budget contribution in the amount of \$25,000 each by the Coachella Valley Water District, Imperial Irrigation District, Imperial County and Riverside County.

We are recommending the use of Community Improvement Funds (\$12,500 from Fourth District and \$12,500 from the Fifth District) for the supplemental budget contribution requested by the Salton Sea Authority.
