SUBJECT: APPEAL BY THE APPLICANT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECEIVE AND FILE ACTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION DECISION TO DENY CHANGE OF ZONE NO. 7584 / CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 3570 – CEQA EXEMPT – Applicant: Jong's Riverside, LLC – Engineer / Representative: Matthew Cotton, Integrated Waste Management Consultant and Vector Engineering, Inc - First Supervisorial District – Lake Mathews Zoning District – Lake Mathews / Woodcrest Area Plan: Community Development: Public Facilities (≤0.60 Floor Area Ratio) – Location: Northerly of Lake Mathews Drive, southerly of El Sobrante Road, easterly of La Sierra Avenue, and westerly of Mc Allister Street – 3.77 Gross Acres - Zoning: Light Agriculture - 1 Acre Minimum (A-1-1) - **REQUEST:** The Change of Zone proposes to amend the text of Ordinance No. 348, Article XIII, Section 13.1, or more specifically the Light Agriculture (A-1) zoning classification to allow for the processing of poultry waste products, the packaging of poultry waste products and the marketing of poultry waste products produced on the property provided a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) is approved by the Riverside County Planning Commission subject to Section 18.28. The Conditional Use Permit is a proposal to legalize an existing, non-permitted, poultry waste management and distribution facility that currently operates within 37,200 square foot unpermitted structure.

Change of Zone No. 7584 and Conditional Use Permit No. 3570, were heard by the Planning Commission on February 6th, 2008. The Planning Commission denied Conditional Use Permit No. 3570 and continued Change of Zone No. 7584 to February 20th, 2008 to adopt findings. The Planning Commission tentatively denied Change of Zone No. 7584 on February 20th, 2008. The project was received and filed by the Board of Supervisors on February 26th, 2008. The appellant filed an appeal on March 7th, 2008 challenging the denial of the project.

Research strongly supports that small children are affected at a significantly greater level by air toxins, chemicals, and/or particulate matter as their breathing rate is faster than adults and their body size is smaller. Additionally, a greater percent of their body is fat tissue (a lesser percent lean tissue, which contains water) and therefore harmful substances that enter their systems are at relatively higher concentration, thus having a potentially more harmful effect to their health. My two younger children (born in 2007 and 2004) have nearly constant excessive mucus secretions in their upper respiratory tract (poor air quality is a possible cause). Furthermore, I was diagnosed with asthma in December 2005. My decline in respiratory health was associated (in terms of timing) with the initiation of fertilizer processing at the

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				nearby farm (behind our home). This health issue was an <u>abrupt</u> change in my health in 2005 particularly. To *deny* any and all applications of Jong's Poultry Farm, Inc., including but not limited to LMS case/permit numbers BEL071000, BAS070060 and BWL070154 relative to any changes in the zoning ordinances or for conditional use permits applicable to property owned by Jong's Poultry Farm, Inc. and/or any other Jong entities or individuals located at or near the street address of 12667 El Sobrante Rd., Riverside, CA;
2. To *deny* any and all applications of Jongs Riverside, LLC, including but not limited to LMS case/permit numbers CFG04937, CUP03570, CZ07584 and EA41592 relative to any changes in the zoning ordinances or for conditional use permits applicable to property owned by Jongs Riverside, LLC and/or any other Jong entities or individuals located at or near the street address of 12667 El Sobrante Rd., Riverside, CA.

Petitioner hereby makes the foregoing requests in light of the facts and for the reasons more particularly set forth below. For the purpose of brevity, the various Jong entities and individuals including Jong's Poultry Farm, Inc., Jongs Riverside, LLC, Jong's Organic Fertilizers, Inc., Charng-Jen Jong, Roger Jong, Joyce Jong, Ru-Yih Jang Jong, Fang-Woei Jong and Fang-Ru Jong will hereinafter be collectively referred to as "the Jongs." Moreover, Petitioner respectfully requests that the members of the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors take official notice of the pleadings and declarations (including all exhibits and photographs) on file in Case No. RIC481467 entitled County of Riverside v. Jongs Riverside, LLC, et al., currently pending in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside as though fully set forth herein (copies of the court file on CD in PDF format may be obtained free of charge by contacting the Victoria Grove Homeowners Coalition at 951-351-0352; in the alternative, the court file may be accessed on the Riverside County Superior Court web site at: <http://www.riverside.courts.ca.gov/pubacc.htm>)

SUMMARY OF FACTS

Petitioner is a resident of Victoria Grove, a planned unit development consisting of more than 1200 homes located east of La Sierra Ave., north of El Sobrante Rd. and west of McAlister Rd. near the north shore of Lake Matthews, a large reservoir owned by the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (containing 179,300 acre feet of water) which serves as the western terminus of the Colorado River Aqueduct. In addition to the homes within the boundaries of the Victoria Grove community, there are two playgrounds, two parks, a basketball court, a baseball diamond and a school (Lake Matthews Elementary).

Sandwiched in between Victoria Grove and Lake Matthews on the south side of El Sobrante Rd. is a series of three adjoining parcels of land totaling approximately 9.4 acres owned by the Jongs upon which approximately 240,000 egg-laying hens reside which produce 60,000 lbs of chicken manure *per day* (1/4 lb. per bird per day) which is transported via conveyor belts to a barn on the center parcel (zoned A-1) where it is dumped into a huge tank where it is manufactured (utilizing a composting process) into Jong's GroBetter Organic Fertilizer after which it is packaged on site. Jong's GroBetter fertilizer is then sold to nurseries throughout California, Nevada and Oregon in addition to being sold over the internet (see www.grobetter.com).

Although most Victoria Grove residents were aware there was a poultry farm somewhere in the vicinity of the development at the time they purchased their homes (beginning with the Shea tract which was begun in 1999-2000), there were few if any complaints regarding the poultry farm (at that time known as the Lakeview Egg Ranch). The poultry farm, located approximately 100 ft. from the southwest boundary of Victoria Grove, was operated with an egg-laying hen population of approximately 80,000 birds. The chicken excrement was collected and removed off site by truck.

Following the purchase of the poultry farm by the Jongs in 2003, work was commenced in 2005 to transform the use of the premises strictly from egg production to a combined use consisting of egg production and fertilizer processing and packaging. In April, 2005, a building permit was obtained on the Jongs' behalf by a contractor to construct a large "pole barn" on the A-1 zoned parcel (Assessor's Parcel No. 285-020-003). However, there is no mention in the documentation on file with the County relative to the construction of the pole barn that the Jongs intended to process and package fertilizer made from the chicken dung on the site, an activity which all parties agree is not allowed on an A-1 zoned parcel.

By the summer of 2005, substantial changes in the manner in which the Jongs' were using their poultry farm were underway. The number of chickens had begun to increase to its present level 240,000. Also, concurrent with the

"modernization" process undertaken by the Jongs, the sides of the seven chicken houses on the larger of the two AP-zoned parcels were changed to being "open-sided" to allow the 30 daily tons of chicken manure to be collected by conveyor belt and transported to the pole barn to be processed into fertilizer. Thereafter, complaints by Victoria Grove residents about the noxious odor began to surface with regularity.

Although several Victoria Grove residents attempted to deal with the increasing number of complaints relating to the odor and particulate matter coming from the Jongs' premises in August, 2006 by meeting Supervisor Bob Buster, the matter subsequently came to a head at a community meeting arranged in cooperation with Supervisor Bob Buster's office at Lake Matthews Elementary School on May 29, 2007. In addition to Supervisor Buster, officials from the Riverside County Planning Department, the South Coast Air Quality Management District and the Metropolitan Water District were present along with several Code Enforcement officers before an overflow crowd of concerned Victoria Grove residents and Lake Matthews Elementary School parents.

Although the Code Enforcement department had corresponded with the Jongs by certified mail requesting an opportunity to inspect the premises prior to the May 29th meeting, Joyce Jong indicated that she had no knowledge of the request. Subsequently, after attempting to inspect the Jongs' premises the day after the community meeting and being denied complete access by Joyce Jong, Code Enforcement officers were forced to obtain inspection warrants and accordingly, were finally able to gain entry to the premises for a complete inspection on June 7, 2007. As set forth in the Declaration of Code Enforcement Officer Brett Farlow (filed in support of the County's Motion for Preliminary Injunction against the Jongs):

During our June 7, 2007 Inspection, we observed plumbing leading to a liquid collection tank, exposed/cracked hot wires coming from the tanks, and water leaking onto the ground from a one (1) inch PVC pipe adjacent to the tanks. Upon further inspection, we observed a 28,000 square foot pole-barn. During the walk-through of the pole-barn, an incredibly strong smell of ammonia, which I immediately concluded to be the source of the odor concerning the surrounding community, emanated from the enclosed pole-barn. I then observed a large tank filled with fermenting chicken excrement, fed by conveyor belts from the agriculture buildings on the side of the pole-barn. Upon exiting, I noticed the packaging equipment and finished product, namely GroBetter Fertilizer, packaged in plastic bags. (Declaration of Brett Farlow, p. 3, lines 3-10.)

During the June 7, 2007 Inspection, Officers Jones, Cruz and I issued seven (7) Notices of Violation. After explaining the violations to Joyce Jong, I posted a Notice of Defects, Danger Do Not Enter sign, the Notices of Violation, and issued a Stop Work Order. (Farlow Declaration, p. 3, lines13-15.)

On August 9, 2007, I searched the Riverside County Land Management System records for current permits applied for or issued to The Property. I found that there were no permits in the applied for or issued status with respect to the processing/packaging of fertilizer. (Farlow Declaration, p. 3, lines 19-21.)

Subsequently, Joyce Jong, on behalf of one or more of the Jong entities filed an application for Change of Zone concurrent with an application for a Conditional Use Permit relative to the unpermitted use to which the Jongs have been putting their A-1 parcel to.

Significantly, the Jongs continued to process and package the fertilizer manufactured inside the pole barn located on their A-1 parcel in flagrant violation of one or more of the citations issued by Officer Farlow on behalf of the County of Riverside. Thereafter, the County of Riverside filed a Complaint for Injunctive Relief and Civil Penalties (Case No. RIC 481467) on September 25, 2007 and proceeded to move for a preliminary injunction which was heard by Judge Bernard Schwartz on November 20, 2007.

In opposition to the County's Motion for Preliminary Injunction, the Jongs filed a memorandum of points and authorities along with several declarations including those of Joyce Jong and Roger Jong in addition to a couple of experts and the builder of the pole barn. Taken as a whole, the Jongs' Opposition makes several curious points. First, although the Jongs continually refer to their composting process utilizing an air scrubber in conjunction with positive air pressure inside the pole barn as "state of the art," Ms. Jong has refused to answer specific questions about the process other than to indicate that it has been used in Europe. Interestingly, residents of Victoria Grove including but not limited to members of the Victoria Grove Homeowners Coalition, have attempted to find references to or studies pertaining to the use of such technology with respect to the composting of chicken excrement into fertilizer in facilities (like the Jongs') located contiguous to large residential developments or to large reservoirs like Lake Matthews and have been unsuccessful. Interestingly, the Jongs' operation is currently being studied by researchers from the University of California including Frank Mitloehner, Ph.D. (whose background is in the area of Animal Science and Agricultural Engineering) from which one can certainly infer that the Jongs' unpermitted chicken manure processing and fertilizer packaging operation

may not be as common-place as the Jongs would have the citizens and officials of Riverside County believe it is.

The second principal ground upon which the Jongs opposed the County's Motion For Preliminary Injunction is an amalgamation of several disingenuous claims which include: 1) the Jongs did not know one of the parcels was zoned A-1 when they bought the property in 2003 (Declaration of Joyce Jong, p. 2, lines 27-28); 2) the Jongs relied on an unknown female County employee in the Land Use Dept. who questioned one of the employees of the pole barn builder about manure management before issuing the building permit "thus authorizing and consenting to the construction of the pole barn for the purpose of drying manure" (Declaration of Antonia Reynolds, p. 2, lines 23-25); 3) the fact that "...[a]t no time during [the first community meeting in August, 2006] did any County official, or anyone else for that matter, mention that the manure processing operation was not permitted under the existing zoning classification" (Declaration of Joyce Jong, p. 3, line 28 to p. 4 lines 1 to 2).

Finally, the Jongs opposed the County's attempt to secure a preliminary injunction by what can only be characterized as a type of "whipsaw" argument which goes as follows. The Jongs, despite their continued defiance of the citations dated June 7, 2007, claim that the public would actually be better off if they are allowed to continue running their chicken fertilizer processing and packaging operation on their A-1 parcel. As succinctly stated by Roger Jong:

If the court grants this preliminary injunction, the existing manure drying system cannot be used and an extreme hardship would be imposed on the farm and its operation. Thousands of tons of manure would be stock piled on the property and could not be removed until the pile dried to a sufficient moisture level, which would take about three (3) to four (4) months, before it can be removed from the farm. The farm simply does not have the open space on the farm to thin bed dry. As a result, the manure in the stock pile will putrefy, produce strong odors and promote a large volume of fly breeding. In turn, the residential community will also be subject to the uncontrollable odor and increased fly population. (Declaration of Roger Jong, p. 3, lines 8 to 15.)

To the consternation of the residents of Victoria Grove and Lake Hills and to County Counsel, Judge Schwartz denied the County's request for a preliminary injunction at the hearing on November 20, 2007. Although County Counsel argued that by denying the County's request for an injunction, the Judge would thereby sanction the Jongs' disregard of the law which would allow them to successfully circumvent the legislative process thereby resulting in a denial of due process to the citizens of Riverside County.

Despite the probable adverse impact on the health and welfare of thousands of men, women and children residing in Victoria Grove and Lake Hills (in addition to the children attending Lake Matthews Elementary), Judge Schwartz felt that the public welfare would be damaged to an even greater extent if he granted the preliminary injunction. His decision was apparently based on the Jongs' claim that if they were not allowed to use the composting method, they would be forced to stockpile the chicken manure all over their land for 3 or 4 months causing increased odor, fly breeding etc., *despite the fact that such a method had never been used on the property nor could it be used due to the fact that the Jongs' property is too small to do so* (Roger Jong Declaration, p. 3, lines 8 to 15).

Moreover, Judge Schwartz voiced concern that irremediable economic hardship would be inflicted on the Jongs if he ordered them to cease their fertilizer processing and packaging operation. It apparently never occurred to the Judge that granting the injunction would have required the Jongs to comply with the citations issued by Code Enforcement on June 7, including the Stop Work Order (which they have refused to do). This in turn would have likely caused them to go back to operating their farm as strictly an egg-laying operation with fewer chickens and the chicken dung being removed from the premises by truck as was the case when the majority of the Victoria Grove residents bought and occupied their homes prior to the inception of the Jongs' fertilizer processing and bagging operation in 2005.

REASONS WHY THE JONGS' APPLICATIONS FOR CHANGES TO THE ZONING ORDINANCES AND FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT SHOULD BE DENIED

Petitioner is informed and believes that there are compelling reasons for the Planning Commission and/or the Board of Supervisors to deny the Jongs' requested changes to the zoning ordinances and to deny their sought-after Conditional Use Permit. First and foremost, the noxious odor and particulate matter which is unpredictably and intermittently dispersed into the air surrounding Victoria Grove and Lake Matthews as a direct result of the Jongs' unpermitted processing and packaging operation on their A-1 parcel constitutes a threat to the health and well being of thousands of nearby residents and to the Lake Matthews Elementary school children from surrounding residential communities who routinely suffer from the effects of the Jongs' fertilizer operation while at school.

While the Jongs' claimed "state of the art" composting method of processing chicken manure utilizing conveyor belts to collect the dung and an air scrubber to attempt to control odor may be touted as an example of enlightened agricultural management, the fact remains that there are no published studies which address the health and environmental issues of an operation like the Jongs' which is shoved in between the shore of a major drinking water reservoir like Lake Matthews which supplies water to hundreds of thousands if not millions of

residents and a series of large residential developments beginning with Victoria Grove which is home to several thousand people.

Pursuant to the Entitlement Process II protocol utilized by the Riverside County Planning Department, a number of Special Studies are clearly warranted with regard to the Jongs' operation including a Biological Study and an Air Quality Analysis as component parts of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR). A sampling of some of the environmental issues include: 1) the impact of the Jongs' operation on Victoria Grove residents and Lake Matthews Elementary school children with respiratory problems; 2) the dispersal pattern and the effects of the gasses and particulate matter discharged by the Jong operation on Lake Matthews Reservoir water and upon MWD's employees who work in close proximity to the fertilizer processing packaging facility; 3) the runoff pattern of water containing rain-diluted chicken manure and other chemicals and chemical by-products from the Jongs' premises (which refers to the dung that falls off the conveyor system onto the ground containing nitrogen and phosphorous which liquefies during rainstorms and either is absorbed into the ground or runs off down hill toward La Sierra Ave. traversing a large MWD water pipeline which runs from Lake Matthews through Victoria Grove to the Robert B. Diemer Treatment Plant in Yorba Linda).

CONCLUSION

Although the Jongs' present use of their two AP-zoned parcels is not specifically pending before the Planning Commission or the Board of Supervisors at present, it is helpful to look at the impact on the surrounding community of the entire Jong

facility comprised of their two AP-zoned parcels and the one A-1-zoned parcel where their fertilizer processing and packaging operations are conducted. Clearly, the controversy involving Victoria Grove and the Jongs is an example of the tension between traditional Riverside County farming interests and the interests of the millions of urbanites who have bolstered the population of Riverside County in recent years and changed the basic character of the local culture.

While the Jongs would like outside observers to conclude that because an egg-laying poultry farm operated for many years on the site they now own prior to the development of Victoria Grove, by right, they should be given a free hand to continue what they started in 2005 to substantially alter the use of the site to include large scale fertilizer processing and packaging in addition to egg production no matter what harm is caused to the residents of Victoria Grove and the surrounding residential developments (note that the Jongs' fertilizer odor has been detected on numerous occasions as far north as the point where the La Sierra Ave. bridge crosses the 91 Freeway).

- o In fact, the Jongs' current operations are a far cry from the notion of a traditional family farm. The reality is that their operations consist of a large scale poultry-based agribusiness which carried on by two corporations and an LLC in Riverside (which is separate from their poultry operations in the Ontario/Chino Hills area) which not only produces eggs from a quarter-million chickens but manufactures fertilizer which is marketed to numerous nurseries on the west coast and also on the Internet;
- o In fact, the Jongs' "poultry farm" is situated in an environmentally precarious area perched at the base of a large reservoir (which itself borders on a Stevens Kangaroo Rat preserve) that provides drinking water to millions of people and a large residential development in excess of 1200 homes where several thousand people live whose homes have a combined value in the hundreds of millions of dollars.

Consequently, it is no surprise that one of the candidates who is running for the Riverside County Board of Supervisors in 2008 has indicated that in his opinion, the Jongs' poultry operation constitutes a Public Nuisance under California Civil Code Sections 3479 and 3480 and that it is not entitled to the protections of Section 5(a) of Riverside County's Right to Farm Ordinance since the changes in use brought about by the commencement of the Jongs' fertilizer processing and packaging operation in 2005 constitute a nuisance by virtually any definition and members of the public began complaining about the stench

from the chicken manure within months, let alone three years as contemplated by the Right to Farm Ordinance.

In light of the foregoing, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Riverside County Planning Commission and/or the Board of Supervisors deny the Jongs' applications for changes to the zoning law or for a Conditional Use Permit relative to the fertilizer processing and bagging operations on their A-1 zoned parcel. Not only is their conduct at odds with the public health and economic welfare of all Victoria Grove residents, but even if it were possible to fashion a list of conditions which the Jongs agreed to abide by in exchange for the ability to carry on their fertilizer processing and packaging operation, the Jongs' high-handed refusal to allow a pre-arranged inspection of the premises (see Farlow Declaration, p. 2, lines 7-19) required the Code Enforcement Officers to obtain an Inspection Warrant. After being cited multiple times for the deficient conditions on their A-1 parcel, the Jongs simply ignored the June 7th Stop Work citation in the most cavalier manner possible *and they have continued to do so for over six months*. This sort of arrogant refusal to follow the law would not likely give the Jongs' most ardent supporter any confidence whatsoever that they would follow the law if it were possible for the Planning Commission to impose reasonable restrictions or conditions, no matter how reasonable they might be.

Finally, although neither the Planning Commission nor the Board of Supervisors sits as a court of equity when taking zoning matters under consideration, basic notions of fairness and justice are still intrinsic to the process. In this instance, the Jongs are seeking permission to use the entirety of their property for egg production albeit at a level (in terms of numbers of chickens) approximately three times greater than the level of 80,000 birds which existed before they commenced their fertilizer processing and packaging in 2005. Whereas the vast majority of Victoria Grove residents had no knowledge concerning the smell of chicken manure prior to 2005, complaints regarding the Jongs' fertilizer processing and packaging activities commenced virtually concurrent with their inception.

While the Jongs are seeking to enhance the income generating ability of their pre-existing poultry operation by manufacturing and selling fertilizer made from chicken waste, the residents of Victoria Grove are simply seeking those things that the Declaration of Independence secures to us as Americans, namely, Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness. In the first place, given the increased risks to health resulting from living in close proximity to the daily accumulation of 60,000 lbs. of chicken manure as it starts to putrefy, it cannot be said that a Victoria Grove resident has the same opportunity to live his or her Life free from increased health risks as do the vast majority of citizens of Riverside County (references to the scientific literature on this topic will be provided upon request).

Second, it cannot be said that Victoria Grove residents have the same ability to exercise their Right to Liberty as the vast majority of Riverside County citizens do

in light of the fact that when the Jongs' Stink suddenly appears, residents must quickly move to imprison themselves within the confines of their own homes by closing all the doors and windows while trying to fight off the gag reflex triggered by the overwhelming stench of hundreds of tons of rotting chicken excrement wafting through the neighborhood. As a consequence, the tens of thousands of dollars that typical homeowners have spent on such big-ticket items as landscaping, patio covers, pools, spas, barbeque islands, outdoor furniture and gardens was entirely wasted. It is indeed a cruel irony that at a time when most Victoria Grove homeowners have reached a point in their lives when they can afford to take the time to enjoy the things that they have worked so hard for that they are effectively kept from doing so by the nuisance created by the Jongs' fertilizer manufacturing business.

On a final note, there can be no question that every single Victoria Grove homeowner is facing the potential of sustaining a very debilitating economic injury in the form of significant diminution of property values as the direct result of the Jongs' misplaced attempt to enhance their poultry farm income at the expense of over one thousand homeowners whose Right to Pursue Happiness in the form of real property appreciation is slowly being destroyed by the Jongs. At this point in time, the precise calculation of the loss has not been undertaken. However, it is not horribly difficult to obtain sales data from comparable residential properties and comparing them to Victoria Grove sales data. In addition to suffering economic loss, both Victoria Grove home sellers and their brokers are being forced to face the prospect of being sued for failing to adequately disclose to a potential buyer Victoria Grove's penchant for suddenly beginning to smell like a dead body for which one cannot prepare for or predict. While specific damage figures have not been calculated, the potential exposure could run well into the six-figure range per homeowner.

I hope the Board of Supervisors will deny any change in Zoning or use permit to the owner of the poultry waste processing plant.
