**BACKGROUND:** (Continued)

This expansion requires training new and current members of the department and to develop a comprehensive training division under one roof. The site of the new Fire training drill tower has no water line to supply water for training exercises. This project would continue the existing water distribution line from Bundy Street to the new training site.

Facilities Management has identified a small portion of the Ben Clark Training Center for the Training Drill Grounds. Ten (10) acres will be developed to create a facility to train and drill current and future firefighters for the Riverside County Fire Department. This facility will house all training equipment, apparatus, and be equipped with the latest hose and drill tower.

The bid documents are now complete and Facilities Management requests approval to solicit bids for construction of this project. The bid documents have been approved by County Counsel as to legal form.
