The Outreach Program is an integral part of the TEEN LINE program. They have provided staff training to Palm Springs Unified School District personnel, and have also made presentations to local middle and high schools. TEEN LINE has been a great success at schools because teens are the ones reaching out to other teens. It is the goal of the program to provide a safety net for teenagers before their problems reach a crisis point.
