

BACKGROUND:

The 11th Annual Year of the Young Child event provides vital information and services at a community-wide event. The Legacy Christian Center holds an annual spring celebration at Replier Park in Banning that drew over 2,000 participants last year. Nuevo Citizen's Patrol is a volunteer group and these funds will cover the cost of gasoline, uniforms and meeting expenses. Good Meadow Community Center provides services to the communities of Good Hope and Meadowbrook; these funds will cover the cost of supplies for operating the center. The Harvest Valley Community Council will be holding a Clean Up Day and these funds will cover the cost of water, food and supplies.
