SUBJECT: Proposed Miscellaneous (Non-Monthly) Parking Rates for FY 2008/09

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Set the proposed parking rates for public hearing on May 6, 2008, (Clerk to advertise); and
2. At the close of the public hearing, approve and adopt the proposed parking rates as specified in Attachment "A" for FY 2008/09.

BACKGROUND: Ordinance 626 establishes county policy for the parking of vehicles on county-owned, leased, or operated parking facilities countywide. In accordance with Ordinance 626, the Department of Facilities Management is proposing new miscellaneous (non-monthly) parking rates for FY 2008/09 to recover costs associated with the provision and enforcement of parking services, as outlined in Attachment "A." The department's current approved parking rates were last adopted in FY 2002/03. The Auditor-Controller has reviewed the proposed rates. (Continued on page 2)

BACKGROUND (continued from Page 1):

As part of the proposed non-monthly parking rate increases, the department proposes charging county departments a nominal rate for parking structure validations (based on \$1 for 1-hour and \$2 for 2-hour parking validations, which is 50% of the proposed hourly rates). In the past, the county has not charged for parking validations. During the period covering January thru March of the current fiscal year, the department processed approximately 21,000 parking validations for the CAC Annex parking structure and about 11,000 parking validations for the 12th Street parking structure.

In accordance with Board Policy B-4, the department intends to review the county's parking rates annually to ensure full cost recovery for parking services. The proposed miscellaneous non-monthly parking rates presented on Attachment "A" would be effective July 1, 2008. Parking rates associated with monthly card holder passes (applicable to the county-owned parking structures located in the downtown Riverside area), as well as related historical information and statistical data, will be presented to the Board of Supervisors under separate cover.
