



BACKGROUND: The River Road Bridge is located on the Santa Ana River within the Prado Dam detention basin. Since construction of the dam, a process of sediment deposition has steadily raised the riverbed at the bridge crossing. This process has severely reduced the waterway opening under the bridge, subjecting it to debris accumulation, overtopping and damage during even modest storm flows within the river. This situation has resulted in closures over extended periods of time and it requires constant sediment removal to maintain the waterway. The bridge's width is substandard for its classification and it is lacking standard shoulders, a sidewalk for pedestrian crossing and an adequate number of traffic lanes to accommodate expected future traffic. The bridge currently does not provide space for a planned regional recreation trail. The proposed project would provide a replacement bridge that would remedy these conditions (and other conditions).

In June 2005, a Final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Environmental Impact Report (EIR) were jointly completed and approved by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), and the Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) to evaluate a range of alternatives for replacing the existing River Road Bridge over the Santa Ana River in Riverside County and selecting a preferred project for subsequent design and construction.

The proposed bridge will be the construction of a four-lane, bridge of 1,200-feet in length with approximately 1,000 feet of approach road on each side of the Santa Ana River. This proposed bridge will replace the existing two-lane, 612-foot long bridge which would correct the noted deficiencies and provide for adequate traffic handling capacity.

The Department of Facilities Management (DOFM) has presented an offer to the property owners as required by Government Code, §7267.2. The price is consistent with current property values in the Norco area based on an independent appraisal report. DOFM has also offered to pay the reasonable costs, not to exceed \$5,000, for an independent appraisal as required by California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1263.025.

Staff recommends approval of Resolution No. 2008-082, Authorizing Resolution of Necessity Regarding the Project to Improve River Road Bridge in Western Riverside County. The approval will permit the River Road Project to move forward.

The Resolution has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to legal form.

1 more highly elevated; and is one to improve a stretch of River Road bounded generally by
2 Kendra Lane on the north and Bluff Street on the south in order to integrate that stretch of road
3 with the new and improved River Road Bridge, and in order to better protect that road from
4 flooding (including, but not limited to, the use of the Subject Properties for public road
5 purposes, for utility purposes, for drainage purposes, for slope purposes, for purposes of a
6 staging area for construction and/or other work, and for other uses incidental to the Proposed
7 Project and required by the Proposed Project);

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors
2 of Riverside County, State of California, not less than four-fifths of all members concurring, in
3 regular session assembled on April 22, 2008, that this Board finds and determines each of the
4 following:

5 1. Notice of the Board's intention to adopt this resolution of necessity was duly given
6 as required by Section 1245.235 of the Code of Civil Procedure and, on the date and at the
7 time and place fixed for hearing, this Board did hear and consider all of the evidence presented.

8 2. The public interest and necessity require the Proposed Project.

9 3. The Proposed Project is planned and located in the manner that will be most
10 compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

11 4. The Subject Property Interests are necessary for the Proposed Project.

12 5. The offers required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code have been made
13 to the owners of record of the Subject Properties.

14 6. To the extent that the Subject Properties are already devoted to a public use, the
15 use of the Proposed Project is a compatible use that will not unreasonably interfere with or
16 impair the continuance of the public use as it presently exists or may reasonably be expected to
17 exist in the future (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.510) or the use of the
18 Proposed Project is a more necessary public use than is the presently existing public use
19 (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.610).

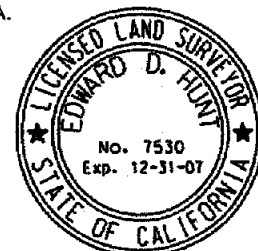


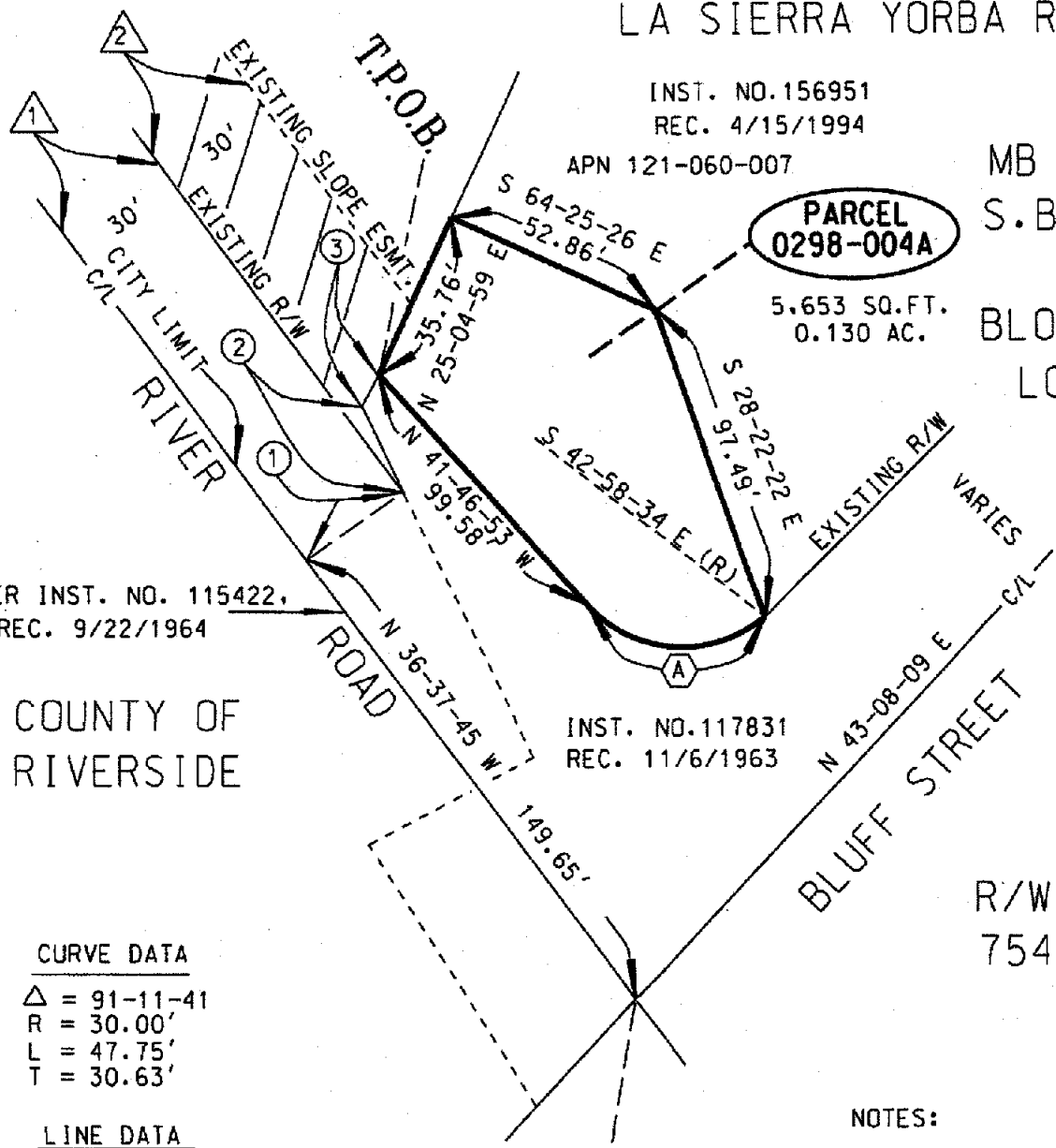

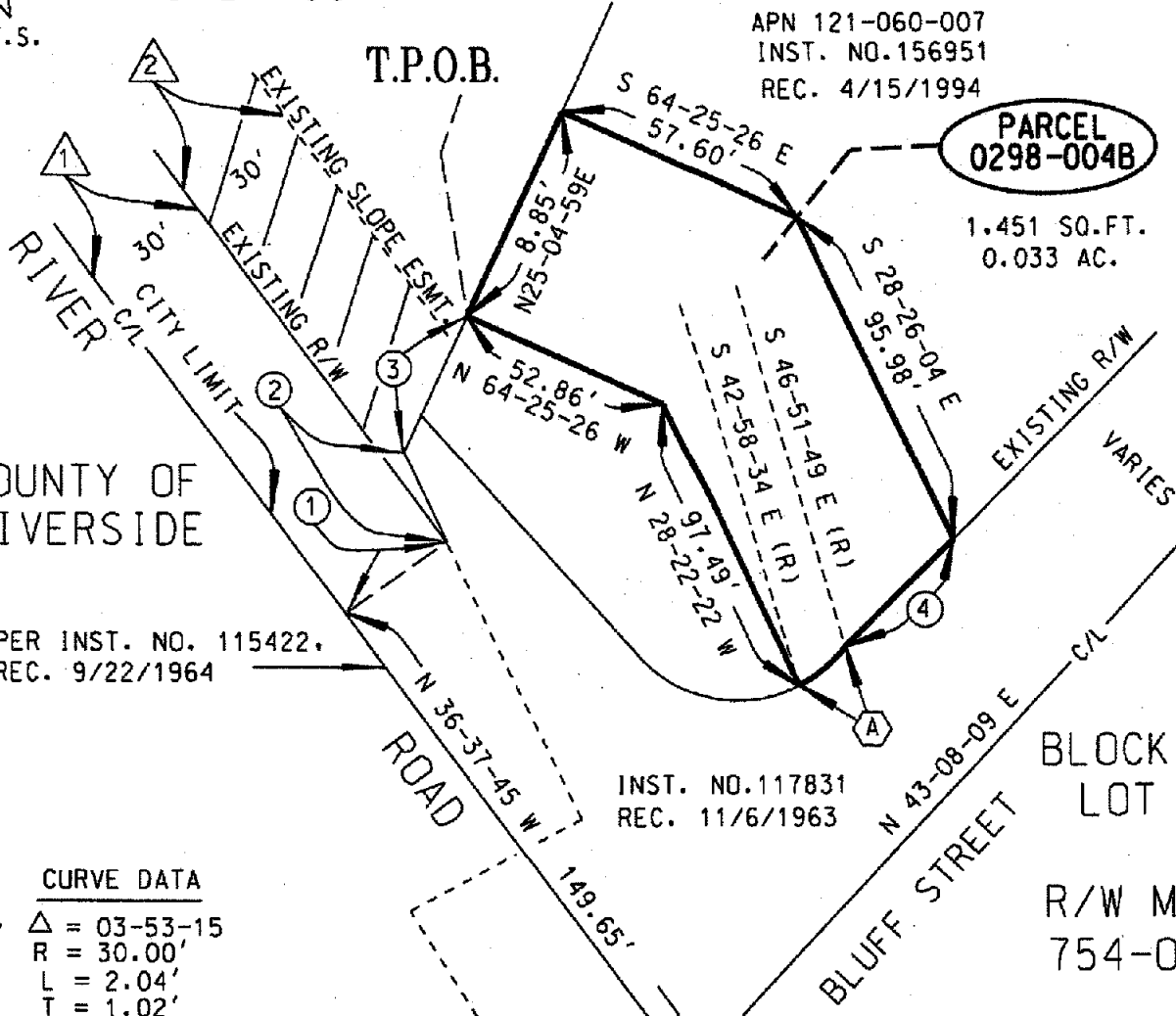
