PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS:

The sidewalk improvements on Claystone Avenue and Canyon Pines Place will provide improved pedestrian facilities for Temescal Valley Elementary School and the neighboring area.

The asphalt concrete walkway improvements on Craig Street will serve as interim pedestrian improvements for Paloma Valley High School and the neighboring area. Permanent improvements will be constructed by future adjacent development.

The sidewalk improvements on Dartmouth Street will provide improved pedestrian facilities for Dartmouth Middle School and Jacob Wiens Elementary School and the neighboring area. The work includes curb and gutter, access ramps and minor roadway improvements.

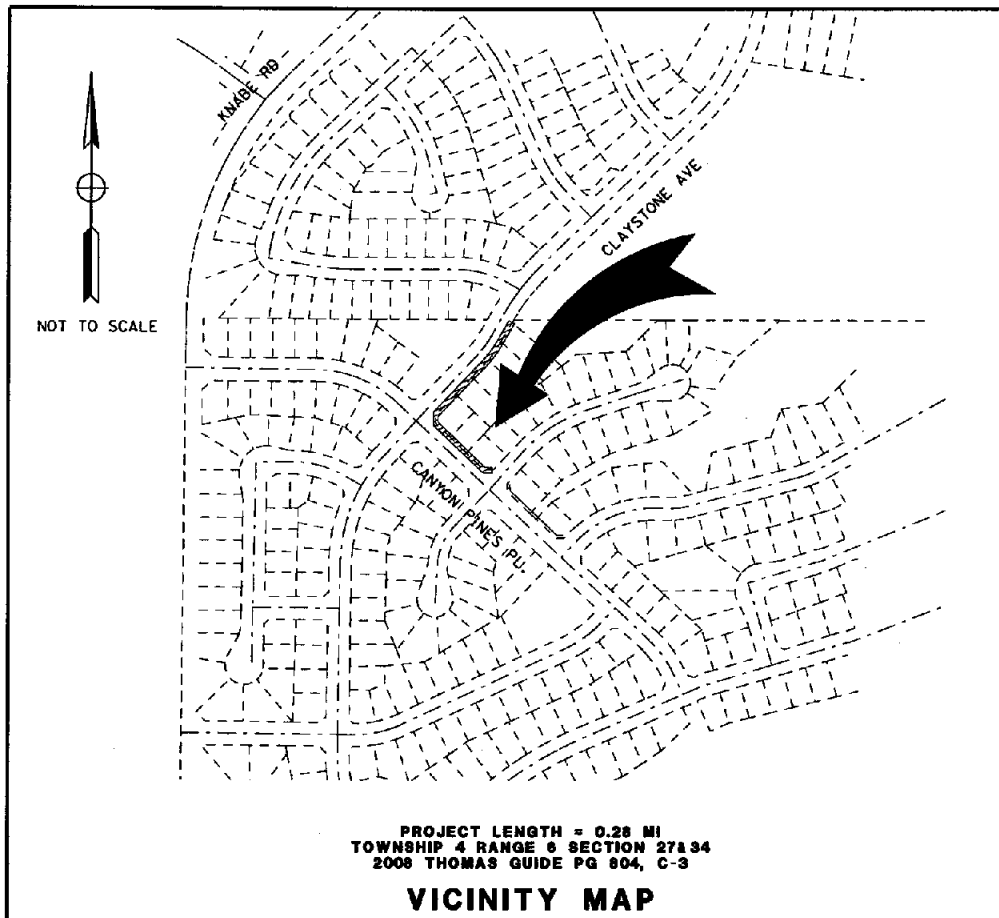
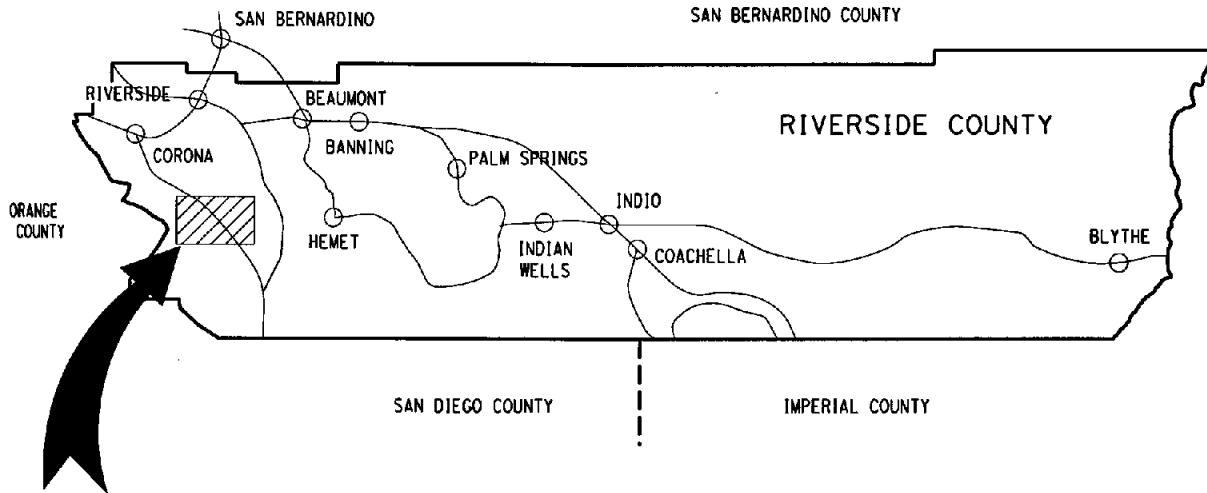
The sidewalk improvements on Center Street will provide needed pedestrian facilities for that mixed residential and commercial area. The work includes curb and gutter, drainage and roadway improvements.

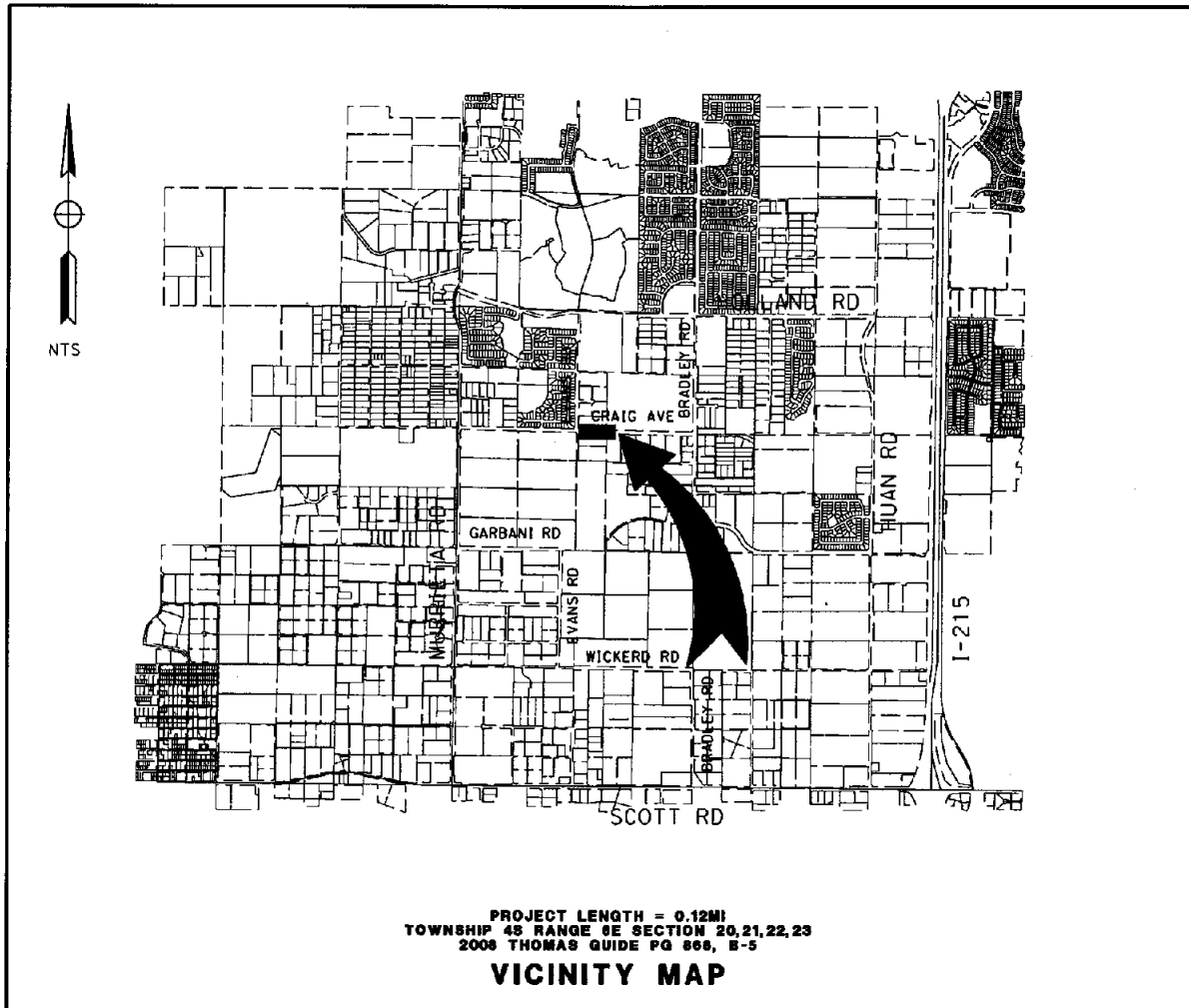
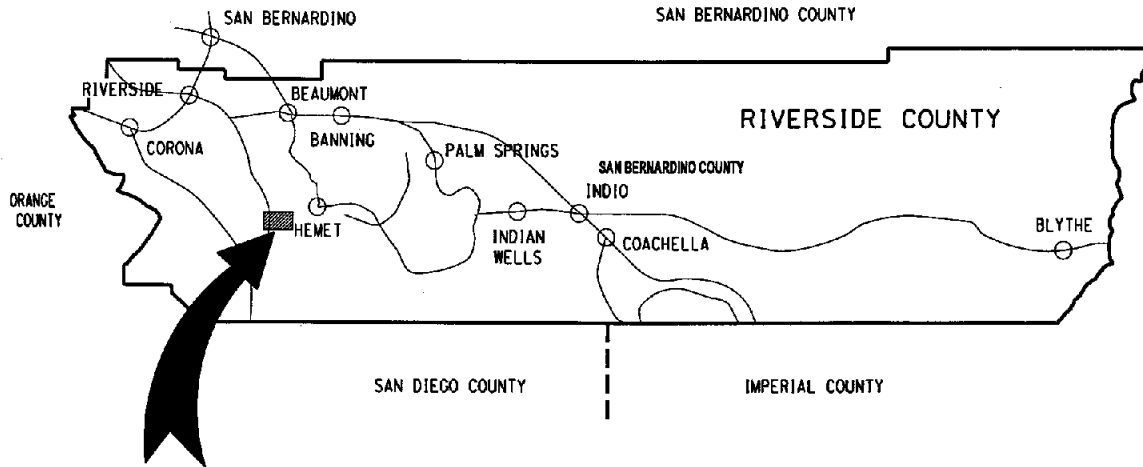
SIDEWALK PROJECT

CRAIG AVE (WO B70745)

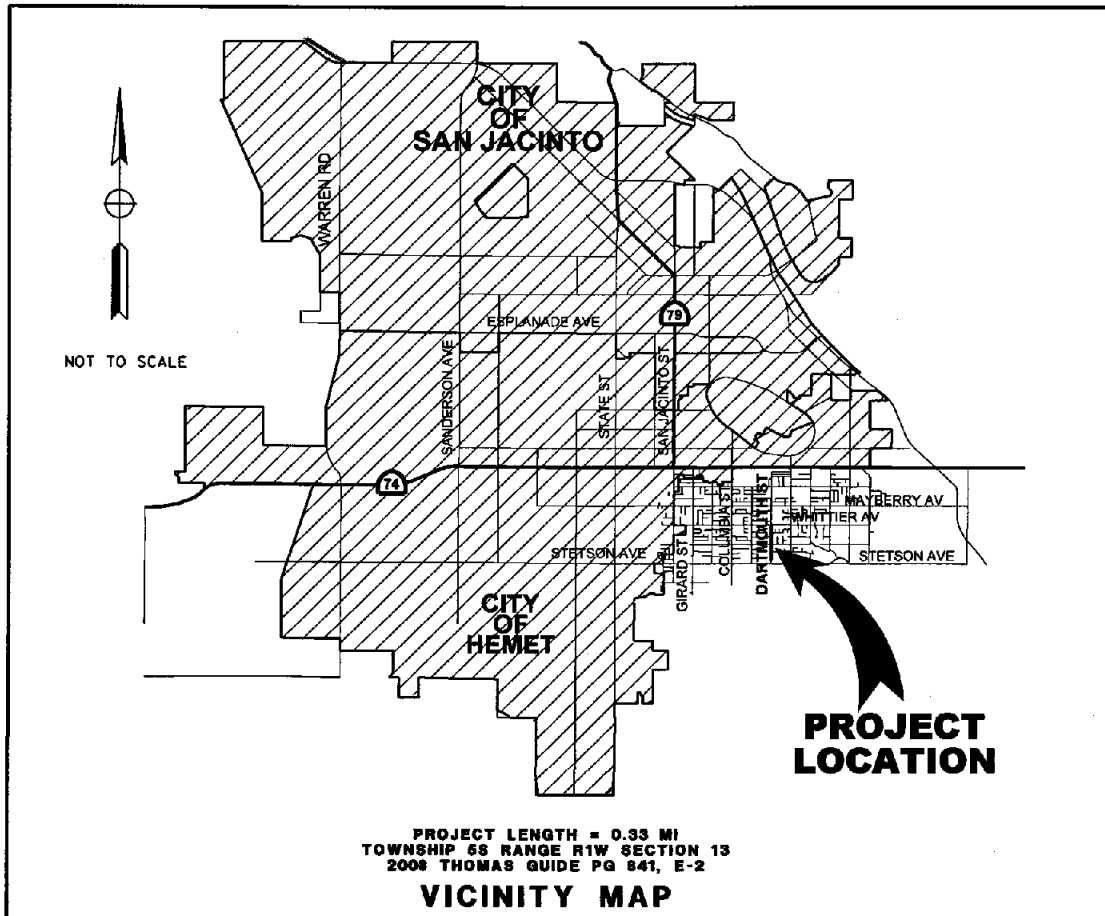
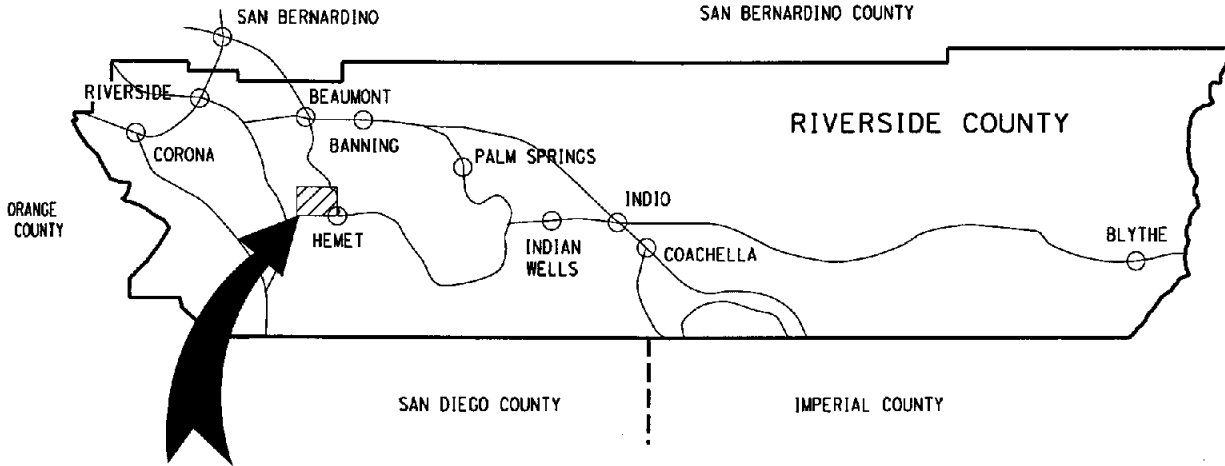
AC WALKWAY PROJECT
