
SUBJECT: County Service Area 85

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve Resolution No. 2008-099 Dissolution of County Service Area 85 Advisory Board

BACKGROUND: Municipal Advisory Councils have been established in many unincorporated communities in Riverside County, and have been very successful in providing input to the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern to the residents.

County Service Area (CSA) 85 provides lighting and park and recreation services and the Advisory Board is currently the only meeting forum for residents of the Western Desert community. As a result, CSA 85 Advisory Board is often asked by residents to intervene on a variety of public issues, such as planning, code enforcement complaints, graffiti, and law enforcement, etc. It is more appropriate that the current Advisory Board be dissolved and the community be represented by the Western Desert MAC that was created by the board on July 31, 2007.

5 **DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA 85 ADVISORY BOARD**

6 **WHEREAS**, on October 13, 1981, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 81-
7 356 Establishing an Advisory Committee for County Service Area No. 85; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on November 7, 2006, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No.
9 2005-148, Adopting Uniform Rules and Procedures for Advisory Committees, Boards and
10 Commissions of the County of Riverside which states that the Board of Supervisors may, at any
11 time and in its sole discretion, dissolve the advisory group by resolution; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 31010 and Riverside County Board Policy No.
13 A-51 provides for the creation of a Municipal Advisory Council within unincorporated territory
14 for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to,
15 public safety, planning, health, transportation, parks and community development; and

16 **WHEREAS**, on July 31, 2007, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 2007-393
17 Creating the West Desert Municipal Advisory Council; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the West Desert Municipal Advisory Council will be tasked with the
19 additional duties to advise on park and recreation issues.

20 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** by the
21 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session
22 assembled on April 29, 2008, that the County Service Area 85 Advisory Board be dissolved and
23 all incumbent advisory board members be removed.
