**SUBJECT:** APPROVE THE INCREASE TO THE AGREEMENT WITH GENERAL SECURITY TO PROVIDE UNARMED SECURITY GUARD SERVICE FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER (RCRMC)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an increase to the agreement with General Security of \$57,871.00 for a new annual amount not to exceed \$327,871.00; and
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute the amendment to the agreement on behalf of the County

**BACKGROUND:** RCRMC and the Purchasing Department issued a formal request for proposal in 2005 to secure qualified Unarmed Guard services at the Arlington Campus Mental Health Inpatient Treatment Facility. General Security was selected as the lowest cost responsive/responsible proposal and the Board of Supervisors approved the agreement on May 3, 2005, agenda item 3.22. This agreement currently provides a minimum of two security officers, twenty four hours a day, seven days per week to insure a safe, calm, secure and peaceful environment for employees and patients.

**SUBJECT: APPROVE THE INCREASE TO THE AGREEMENT WITH GENERAL SECURITY TO PROVIDE UNARMED SECURITY GUARD SERVICE FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER (RCRMC)**

**BACKGROUND (Continued):**

This amendment is to add funding for an additional security officer to be assigned ten hours per day, seven days a week at the new Mental Health Urgent Care Clinic. RCRMC will be reimbursed the cost for this additional officer by the Department of Mental Health.

In addition, the contractor has asked for an increase to the rate paid to allow for the California State Minimum Wage increase effective January, 2008.

**PRICE REASONABLENESS:**

General Security was the lowest responsible/responsive cost proposal and a four percent rate increase was agreed upon with the contractor after extensive negotiation. This rate increase is to be effective January 1, 2008, as an adjustment to offset their imposed minimum wage increase.
