**BACKGROUND:** The State wishes to relinquish to the County Old State Route 86 and portions of Route 111 and 195 located in the unincorporated areas of Thermal and Mecca. The Board of Supervisors previously approved the Cooperative Agreement on September 27, 2005 (Agenda Item 3.53). Amendment No. 1 which was approved on July 25, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.53) acknowledged that parts of the relinquished highways are located within the Torres-Martinez
