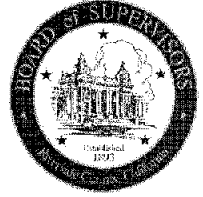

3 RESOLUTION NO. 2008-229

4 DISSOLVING THE WILDOMAR MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

5 WHEREAS, the Wildomar Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) was created on  
6 October 11, 1988, for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not  
7 limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works and planning, and

8 WHEREAS, for the past two decades the MAC has provided input to the Board of  
9 Supervisors on numerous matters regarding the Wildomar community, and

10 WHEREAS, on February 5, 2008, the voters within the Wildomar community adopted  
11 Measure C approving the proposed incorporation of the City of Wildomar, and

12 WHEREAS, the creation of a City Council to handle the affairs of the newly incorporated  
13 City of Wildomar serve as the municipal body to accede to the functions of the MAC, and

14 WHEREAS, Resolution 2005-148 Adopting Uniform Procedures for Advisory  
15 Committees, Boards and Commissions, provides for the dissolutions of an advisory committee no longer  
16 required for its original purpose.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
18 Riverside assembled in regular session on Tuesday, May 6, 2008, that the Wildomar Municipal  
19 Advisory Council is dissolved, effective June 30, 2008.
