**SUBJECT:** Extension of Loan of Voting Equipment to the City and County of San Francisco

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve an extension of the loan of 630 DRE Edge II voting units to the City and County of San Francisco for use in the June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election

**BACKGROUND:** The City and County of San Francisco (San Francisco) has submitted a formal request letter to the Registrar of Voters seeking an extension of the time in which San Francisco uses the 630 Edge II voting units borrowed from Riverside County for the February 5, 2008 Presidential Primary Election. San Francisco was required to conduct a special election in April which delayed their ability to accept and test their new voting system equipment in time for the June Primary. San Francisco assures that they will continue to properly care for the equipment and will return it to our warehouse shortly after the June election.

Board Policy H-3 prohibits the loaning of election equipment without Board of Supervisors approval.

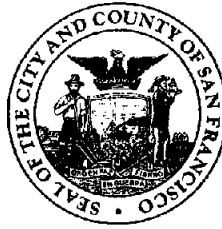


Dear Barbara:
