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BACKGROUND:

The Agreement is necessary to provide for District construction inspection of the subject stormwater management facilities associated with Site Plan PA04-0058 in the city of Moreno Valley. Upon completion of construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the main line storm drain facility. The City will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the facilities' associated catch basins, laterals and connector pipes located within its rights of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form, and the Developer and the City have executed the Agreement.

The Developer is funding all construction and construction inspection costs. Future operation and maintenance costs will accrue to the District.
