**BACKGROUND:** The Indian Avenue at Interstate 10 Interchange project is an identified high priority facility in CVAG's Regional Arterial Program.

Amendment No. 6 allocates an additional \$385,000, for the lead agency, the City of Palm Springs, for additional design costs needed for the project. This increases the total project costs

to \$17,078,563, funded using Coachella Valley 2002 STIP formula Funds, for the construction of the Indian Avenue Interstate 10 Interchange project.

Based on the original agreement, CVAG will advance funds for this project and the COUNTY and CITY shall reimburse CVAG for their share of the costs as defined in the agreement. The COUNTY's share for this amendment is \$26,757.50 which is 6.95% of cost for this amendment.
