SUBJECT: Third Supervisorial District Community Clean Up Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board join with me in authorizing the Riverside County Waste Management Department to waive the fees for the disposal of the yard waste and debris generated by residents participating in the community clean up, at the County's Lamb's Canyon Landfill and the El Sobrante Landfill from Thursday, May 29 through Sunday, June 1, 2008.

BACKGROUND:

The residents within the unincorporated area of the Third Supervisorial District have requested another annual clean up of yard waste with free disposal of those wastes at the Lamb's Canyon and El Sobrante landfills from Thursday, May 29 through Sunday, June 1, 2008.

The Riverside County Waste Management Department will waive tipping fees for the disposal of wastes for residents living within the boundaries of the Third Supervisorial District, brought to the landfill by private pick up trucks and cars, and upon presentation of a valid California Driver's License showing a zip code within these boundaries.

Waste generated by building contractors, roofers, gardeners and other business/commercial establishments are not included in the disposal fee waiver.

THIRD DISTRICT COMMUNITY CLEAN UP
Thursday, May 29 – Sunday, June 1, 2008

Riverside County Third District Supervisor Jeff Stone and the Riverside County Waste Management Department are offering the use of the Lamb's Canyon and El Sobrante Landfills at no charge from Thursday, May 29 through Sunday, June 1, 2008.

By presenting a valid California Driver's License with a zip code within the Third District unincorporated area, individuals may use the disposal site at no cost during these dates only. This does not include any commercial contractors, i.e. gardeners, roofers, contractors, etc. Lamb's Canyon Disposal Site is located at 16411 Lamb's Canyon Road, Beaumont, and is open 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. and the El Sobrante Landfill is located at 10910 Dawson Canyon Road, Corona, and is open 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. El Sobrante Landfill will not be open on Sunday, June 1 – waste will have to be taken to the Lamb's Canyon landfill on that day. **No hazardous waste will be accepted at the disposal sites.**

This clean up program is not available to residents of cities within the Third District who sponsor their own separate cleanup programs at other times of the year. You can get further information by contacting your city.
