

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

4. Appoint Dean Klockenteger, 38951 Vista Dawn Court, Temecula, CA 92592, to fill the empty VAC At-Large vacancy with a term to expire June 30, 2010.

BACKGROUND: Mr. Mizak is an Air Force veteran, served in Vietnam, and was nominated for VAC membership by VFW Post 9223, Riverside, CA. He has been active in the VFW, the American Legion and the RNC Memorial Honor Detail.

Mr. Hagen is a Navy Veteran, also served in Vietnam, and was nominated by AMVETS Post 66, Rancho Mirage, CA. He has been active in the Navy League And the AMVETS-Express transportation service, transporting veterans from the Coachella Valley to the Loma Linda VA Medical Center.

Ms. Powell retired from the Military as a Chief Master Sergeant after serving 38 years in the USAF, Air Forces Reserves and the California Air National Guard. She has an extensive background in the medical and aero-space industries Combining management, quality control and training skills and experience.

Mr. Klockenteger is an active member of the VFW and attends VAC meetings and Supports all VAC activities. If confirmed by the Board he will be an excellent addition to the VAC.

At the VAC's regular April 1, 2008 meeting, the district representatives present voted to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that Mr. Mizak, Mr. Hagen and Ms. Powell re-appointed to fill the three At-Large positions and that Mr. Klockenteger be appointed to a new 2-year term.
