- 3) Authorize the Director of Community Health Agency to sign School Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (SMAA) agreements between the Community Health Agency and Local Education Agencies on behalf of the County of Riverside.

4) Authorize receipt of funds into an Agency fund (fund #65720) to be held for distribution; and

5) Authorize the Director of Community Health Agency (CHA) to collect a proportional amount of monies from participating school districts for costs incurred in the coordination of this Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

On July 21, 1992, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Health Services Agency Director to coordinate SB-910 implementation activities for the County, of which Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) is a part. In order to continue participation in the MAA program, a new Agreement with the California State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) must be signed. As of July 1, 2008 DHCS has stated that for the County to represent currently contracted School Districts that a separate contract must exist between the County and the School Based Medi-Cal Activities unit of DHCS.

This Agreement continues to allow contracted School Districts to receive Federal Financial Participation (FFP) for Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, via the State's Administrative Plan for eligible pupils. The Community Health Agency is acting as the single County Agency through which claims will be made under this Agreement. The Agency is anticipating annual funding of \$250,000 from this contract. A budget adjustment is not required in the Agency Budget. The County is currently contracted with 1 Community College, 16 School Districts and the County of Riverside Office of Education.
