**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Agreement with Olive Crest Treatment Center for FY 07/08.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify the Agreement between Olive Crest Treatment Center and the Department of Mental Health (DOMH) for children's mental health and wraparound services;
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreement; and
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to renew, decrease and/or increase this agreement annually through June 30, 2013; and exempt the Purchasing Agent from obtaining a sole source justification.

**BACKGROUND:** Olive Crest Treatment Center, a private, non-profit, community-based organization, has provided care for over 40,000 children and families since 1973. Olive Crest is dedicated to preventing child abuse; to treating and educating at-risk children; and to preserving the family structure.

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**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Agreement with Olive Crest Treatment Center for FY 07/08.

**BACKGROUND: (Cont'd)**

There are two significant components in the contract, the mental health services and the wraparound services.

The mental health services component will reach minors who are considered to be full scope, Medi-Cal recipients residing in the greater Riverside area. Eligible minors must be emotionally disturbed with medical necessity and are residents in an Olive Crest operated group home, a Foster Family Agency Home, or a youth discharged from the Olive Crest Wraparound Program.

The wraparound services component will reach minors who are considered to be full scope, Medi-Cal recipients residing in the greater Riverside area as well. Olive Crest will provide a full range of services including assessment, individual therapy, crisis intervention and case management.

For mental health services, Olive Crest Treatment Center has been a DOMH provider under Managed Care. Historically, Olive Crest has provided mental health and wraparound services to Los Angeles, Orange County and San Diego County youth. Wraparound services were RFP'd by the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) in January of 2007. Olive Crest Treatment Center was determined to be a successful bidder to provide these services for the County of Riverside in August of 2007. Because DOMH is the lead agency for Medi-Cal billed mental health services, which include wraparound services, DOMH is expanding the contract with Olive Crest in order to reimburse Olive Crest for DPSS wraparound clients.

**PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:**

This agreement is effective from January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008. This agreement may be renewed annually through June 30, 2013, and includes a termination clause if Federal, State and/or County funds should become unavailable.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

This Agreement is budgeted for six (6) months of service totaling \$350,003 for FY 07/08. No additional County funds are required. Under this contract, Olive Crest will only be paid for the services provided to children that are 100% Medi-Cal reimbursable.

**JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY:**

Olive Crest Treatment Center signed the contract in December 2007. However, the DOMH did not receive the contract back from the provider ready for Board approval until April 2008.
