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

- (1) The substandard structure (single story wood structure) on the real property located at 23800 Curtin Road, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County, California, APN 647-300-019 be declared a public nuisance and a violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 457 which does not permit substandard structures on the property.
- (2) Leticia Ruiz and Adolfo Ruiz, the owners of the subject real property, be directed to abate the substandard structure on the property by rehabilitating, removing and/or demolishing the same from the real property, including the removal and disposal of all structural debris and materials, within ninety (90) days.

- (3) The owners be ordered to ascertain the existence or non-existence of asbestos containing materials in said structure by survey and materials sample testing through the Industrial Hygiene Specialist of the County Health Department, Division of Special Services; and, prior to the abatement ordered in paragraph number two (2) above, to secure the removal and disposal of all asbestos containing materials discovered through such survey and testing by contract with a duly certified and licensed contractor for the handling of such materials to avoid citations and/or fines imposed by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) pursuant to SCAQMD Rule No. 1403.
- (4) The accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 23800 Curtin Road, Desert Hot Springs, be declared a public nuisance and a violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 which does not permit the accumulation of rubbish on the property.
- (5) Leticia Ruiz and Adolfo Ruiz, the owners of the subject property, be directed to abate the accumulation of rubbish on the property by removing and disposing of the same from the real property within ninety (90) days.
- (6) If the owners of the real property do not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent of the owners, receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property, or other authorization as provided by law, shall abate the substandard structure and the accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property, including the removal and disposal of all structural debris and contents therein.
- (7) The reasonable cost of the abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Ordinance No. 725.
- (8) County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law that the substandard structure on the real property and the accumulation of rubbish are declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 and 541 and constitute a public nuisance. Further, County Counsel shall prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

JUSTIFICATION:

1. An initial inspection was made of the subject real property by the Code Enforcement Officer on July 3, 2007.
2. The inspection revealed a substandard structure (single story wood structure) on the subject real property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 457. The substandard conditions of the structure included, but were not limited to the following: lack of or improper water closet, lavatory, bathtub, shower or kitchen sink; lack of hot and cold running water to plumbing fixtures; hazardous plumbing; lack of required electrical lighting, there is no power to the unit and electrical fixtures are missing; hazardous wiring; lack of adequate heating facilities; members of walls, partitions or other vertical supports that split, lean, list or buckle due to defective material or deterioration; members of ceilings, roofs, ceiling and roof supports or other horizontal members which sag, split or buckle due

to defective material or deterioration; faulty weather protection; fire hazard, general dilapidation or improper maintenance; and abandoned, vacant, public and attractive nuisance. The inspection also revealed the accumulation of rubbish (approximately 320 square feet) on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541. The accumulation of rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to the following materials: household trash, furniture, discarded clothing, wood and scrap metal.

3. Subsequent inspections of the above-described real property on September 4, 2007, December 11, 2007, March 4, 2008 and April 24, 2008, revealed that the property continues to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 and 541.
4. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for substandard structures and accumulated rubbish.
