directed to cause the appropriate resolution, based on the election tally, to be prepared and returned to the Board for its consideration.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2008-180 adopted April 15, 2008, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for June 3, 2008, to receive testimony regarding the New Improvements (fossil filters) for Zone 90 of Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). An additional assessment on all parcels within Zone 90 of \$24.70 per parcel will fund the New Improvements (the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters) within public rights-of-way located southwesterly of Palomar St and southeasterly of McVicar St in the Wildomar area and includes 101 single-family residential lots.

On April 16, 2008 a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2008-180, and an information sheet was mailed to all property owners within Zone 90, regarding the New Improvements. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2008-180 in The Press Enterprise at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of the Resolution No. 2008-180 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two other public locations within the County.

Section 53753 of the Government Code has been amended. It requires that the Board after conducting the public hearing designate an impartial person, having no vested interest in the outcome of the proposed New Improvements, to tally the ballots received by the close of the public hearing at a specified time, date and place.
