**BACKGROUND:**

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which Consultant will perform consulting services for the District's Low Impact Development (LID) testing and Demonstration Facility, and remodel the District's Front Parking Lot. The LID facility is a grant project partially funded with Proposition 13 dollars from the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA). Consultant provided initial engineering services for the grant application under an existing District Agreement. LID is an evolving field and Consultant has specific experience applying LID technologies such as porous pavements in San Diego County. Given Consultant's familiarity with the project, past experience implementing LID technologies, and the District's need to move forward with the project in a timely fashion because of the grant's deadline, the District has selected Consultant to prepare final plans and specifications.
