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BACKGROUND:

The Agreement is necessary to provide for District construction inspection of the referenced facilities associated with the widening of Pigeon Pass Road. Upon completion of the facilities' construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drains and slope protection. The County will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the associated catch basin and connector pipe located within its rights of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the City has executed the Agreement. This matter is also on the County's Board Agenda for approval this same date.

The City of Moreno Valley is funding all construction and construction inspection costs. Future operation and maintenance costs will accrue to the District.

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
