
**SUBJECT:** Minor change to boundary of Thousand Palms Community Council.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve a minor change in the boundary to the Thousand Palms Community Council to allow for formation of "Desert Palms Community Council" in a subsequent item on this agenda. This change, indicated on Exhibit A, moves the boundary line west from the current alignment of Washington Street to the former alignment, designating the Washington Street fire facility to fall within the boundaries of the new "Desert Palms Community Council."

**BACKGROUND:**

Residents of the community of Sun City Palm Desert want to be represented by a community council, and that request appears on this June 10 agenda. In drawing the boundaries for the new community council, care was taken to avoid intruding into the boundaries of the existing Thousand Palms Community Council immediately east of the new council. However, in during preparation of the boundaries, Fourth District staff found one slight adjustment is justified: Since Del Webb Corporation donated the land that the current Washington Street fire station (station #81) was built on, the community of Sun City feels some "ownership." Since the service levels will not change for either community with this accommodation, and since the community of Thousand Palms does not have any objections (community council members were informally surveyed on this matter), this boundary change should be allowed to take place. It is worth noting that the community of Thousand Palms is about to become home to a new \$11.5 million fire station and training center centrally located in the community.

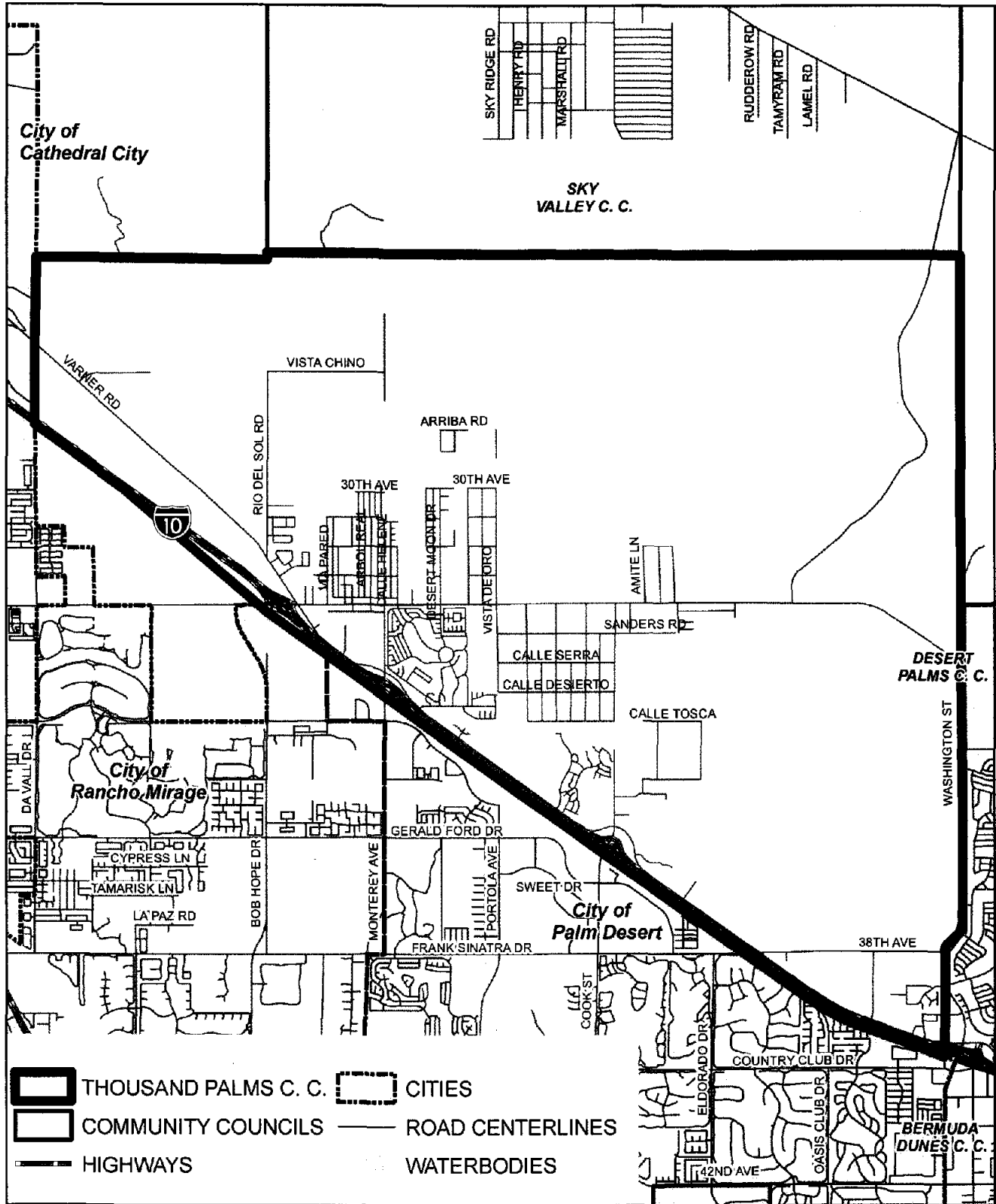

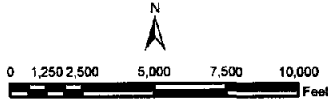
