SUBJECT: Approval of the Professional Services Agreement between the County of Riverside DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc. and approval of the First Amendment to the Professional Faculty Services Agreement with DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- 1) Approve the Professional Services Agreement with DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc. and approve the First Amendment to the Professional Faculty Services with DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group Inc.;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign three (3) copies of the agreement and four (4) copies of the amendment;
- 3) Retain one (1) copy of the agreement and one (1) copy of the amendment and return two (2) copies of the executed agreements and three (3) copies of the executed amendments to Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) for distribution.

BACKGROUND: On February 7, 1989, Agenda No. 3.34, the Board of Supervisors approved the contract with DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group for the provision of comprehensive orthopaedic surgery professional services to the patients at RCRMC on an inpatient, outpatient and emergency basis. The DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc., has provided orthopaedic specialty care professional surgical services to Riverside General Hospital (RGH) and RCRMC for over nineteen years.

SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to the Professional Faculty Services Agreement and the Professional Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc.

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

The continuing increase in the number of trauma patients requiring orthopaedic surgical intervention along with an increasing number of patients referred for outpatient orthopaedic consultation services has necessitated an increase in orthopedic surgery coverage for the Hospital. This new agreement increases the number of orthopaedic surgeons from 4 1/2 to 6 FTE orthopaedic specialists, including a pediatric orthopaedic specialist and an additional two (2) half-day clinics are added per week increasing patients' access to care and decreasing the backlog in orthopaedic appointments.

All of the required services, including teaching, oversight and administrative responsibilities have been incorporated into the professional services agreement.

On June 8, 2004, Agenda No. 3.44, the Board approved a Professional Faculty Services Agreement between DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc., and the County of Riverside (RCRMC) to implement and provide oversight to the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) accredited Physician Residency Training Program in orthopedic surgery. RCRMC gained accreditation for this program in May 2002, which has proven to be successful and beneficial to the County of Riverside.

The Traditional Rotating Intern Programs have been eliminated nationwide; therefore, the RCRMC Orthopaedic Surgery Department is expanding its Physician Residency Training Program in orthopaedic surgery, which also includes a Physician Assistant Fellow Training Program. This amendment is necessary to accommodate the RCRMC accreditation/certification of the Orthopaedic Surgery Resident Program and Physician Assistant Fellow Training Program to ensure the residents of the County of Riverside receive the necessary and appropriate medical services in an efficient and timely manner.

These Agreements have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

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SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to the Professional Faculty Services Agreement and the Professional Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and DeAnza Orthopaedic Medical Group, Inc.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT: Professional Services Agreement

- 1.) Maximum annual compensation payable under this agreement is one million, four hundred thousand (\$1,400,000) dollars
- 2.) There are financial penalties associated with performance standards

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Professional Faculty Services Agreement

This agreement is being amended to increase the maximum obligation by \$33,900, which includes an increase of \$5,000 annually for the salary of the Program Director, \$10,000 annually for the salary of the Assistant Program Director and \$18,900 for the additional training, licensing and educational materials for fifteen (15) physician residents in training. The Professional Services Agreement with DeAnza Orthopedic Medical Group has not been increased for 19 years while census volumes have increased dramatically requiring an increase in the orthopedic services provided. Funding for this agreement has been requested in the 2008/09 budget for RCRMC. The additional orthopedic surgical cases and related professional services are projected to generate additional revenue to cover the cost.
