**SUBJECT:** Renaming of San Sevaine/Bain Street Regional Trail to the Jim Real Regional Trail


**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors rename the San Sevaine/Bain Street Regional Trail to the Jim Real Regional Trail.

**BACKGROUND:** The Bain Street Trail is the southern most portion of the County's adopted regional trail along the San Sevaine Channel. The completion of the 2.5 mile Bain Street Trail provides an important trail link connecting the Santa Ana River Trail to the established multi-purpose trail system in the Mira Loma area at Bellegrave/Galena Avenue.

Jim Real served as a member of the Santa Ana River Parkway Technical Advisory Committee and Chair of the Operations and Maintenance Subcommittee to assist with the coordination of activities along the river to ensure consistency, facilitate planning and share resources to provide for a trail system that is accessible to more than seven million people, with the creation of a 110 mile-long river that serves the diverse needs of Riverside, Orange and San Bernardino counties as a recreation parkway along the Santa Ana River.

Further, Jim Real served as Chair of the Riverside County Regional Park & Open Space District Advisory Commission and Chair of the Riverside County Trails Committee. He was also very involved with trails in his local community of Jurupa and Mira Loma, as well as trails throughout the State of California.

Jim Real passed away in September 2007 and it is my hope that this very important portion of the regional trail could be named after Jim, in recognition of his tireless efforts to help provide a trails system to the residents of Riverside County.
