**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH GLOBAL TEL*LINK CORPORATION
FOR INMATE TELEPHONE SERVICE**

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute the second amendment to the Inmate Telephone Service Agreement with Global Tel*Link Corporation to allow extension of the service on a month-to-month basis, not to exceed 18 months, without securing competitive bids, in accordance with Ordinance 459.4, while the Sheriff and the Purchasing Departments develop and complete a Request for Proposal.

BACKGROUND: In September 2005, the Board of Supervisors approved Global Tel*Link Corporation's (Global) assumption of the Agreement for the County's Inmate Telephone Service from AT&T (9/27/05, Item 3.38). This Service Agreement terminated on June 30, 2008, and the Sheriff's Department and County Purchasing now agree that the service should be offered for competitive bid.

Until a contract has been awarded based on the results of a competitive bid, Global Tel*Link has agreed to a month-to-month contract. However, it has specified a schedule of declining revenues payable to the County for each 6-month period during the 18-month contract term. Nevertheless, the Sheriff's Department and County Purchasing are confident that a contract can be awarded within the first quarter of calendar year 2009.
