SUBJECT: FY07 Buffer Zone Protection Grant Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept the FY07 Buffer Zone Protection Grant Program (BZPP) award in the amount of \$187,013 on behalf of Riverside County;
2. Adoption of Riverside County Resolution Number 2008-344, designation of Authorized Agents under the FY07 BZPP.

BACKGROUND: The Governor's Office of Homeland Security, the Office of Domestic Preparedness, and the Department of Homeland Security Information Analysis and Infrastructure Protection Directorate provide protective action BZPP equipment and management funding to Operational Areas to protect and secure critical infrastructure and key resource sites across the country. BZPP is designed to reduce vulnerabilities to sites by extending the protected area around a site into the surrounding community and supporting the prevention and preparedness efforts of local law enforcement first responders. Riverside County Operational Area applied for and will receive pass through funding on behalf of the first responders in the Sheriff's Department to harden a federally-determined law enforcement sensitive critical infrastructure in Riverside County. 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BZPP provides a total of \$192,500 in funding which is inclusive of state and local administrative fees. After the State deducts its portion of the fees, the County receives \$187,013.

On July 3, 2008 Riverside County Operational Area received notification that we received spending approval for a total of \$187,013.
