The Riverside County Office on Aging Grandparents Raising Grandchildren program will provide full time and respite subsidized child care slots to the underserved community of grandparents/caregivers residing in Riverside County who are caring for children 0-5 years of age. The GRG program will serve low to moderate income grandparents/caregivers.

In addition, the program will provide a family assessment, referrals and follow-up services to those families who are in need.

First 5 Riverside is providing a contract amount of \$405,950 for Fiscal Year 08/09.
