
Term of Appointment: Terms expire Jan. 31, 2011, except that Max Schoenrock's term will expire Jan. 31, 2009, in order to stagger the reappointment dates.

(or previous appointment) Full underlying term is 4 years.

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

The 4-year terms of the existing board members ended on January 31, 2007. The Palo Verde Cemetery District "Board of Trustees General Provisions and Government" states that the Board of Supervisors will appoint the three members, and that "The trustees shall hold office for four years and until the appointment and qualifications of their successors." These vacancies were duly posted by the clerk of the board and the applications have been thoroughly reviewed. Based upon the District's current fiscal concerns, greater emphasis was placed on an applicant's fiscal background.

Doris Morgan is a former Mayor of Blythe, with a substantial financial background. Max Schoenrock is current Chairman of the Desert Alliance for Community Empowerment (DACE) Board of Directors and also a member of the Mesa Verde Community Council. Beatrice Pinon, office manager for Blythe Ambulance, is a member of the Colorado River Country Fair Board with extensive knowledge of the District's history and practices. All three have indicated their intense interest in serving on this panel.
