**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF JUVENILE JUSTICE CRIME PREVENTION ACT (JJCPA)
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS**

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Approve the agreements with Boys and Girls Club of Coachella Valley for \$186,966, MFI Recovery Center for \$83,096, Carolyn E. Wylie Center for \$83,096, Family Service Association of Western Riverside County for \$83,096, and Operation SafeHouse, Inc., for \$20,774 for an annual aggregate amount of \$457,028, for five years, renewable in one-year increments in accordance with Ordinance 459.4, and;
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign amendments, move funds between the vendors not to exceed the annual amount, and exercise the renewal options.

BACKGROUND: The State has allocated funds for the continuation of programs through the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) for FY 2008/09. A major component of the County's plan is the school-based Youth Accountability Teams (YAT) made up of probation and law enforcement officers,



BACKGROUND (Continued)

deputy district attorneys, and contract community based organization (CBO) paraprofessional counselors. There are currently 19 YAT teams located on middle and high school campuses and at community locations from Blythe to Corona. YAT teams focus on delinquency prevention through early intervention.

PRICE REASONABLENESS: On April 29, 2008, County Purchasing issued a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) PRARC015 on behalf of the Probation Department to obtain competitive proposals from qualified bidders to provide outreach youth counseling services for the 19 YAT teams. RFP's were sent to seven potential bidders and advertised on the County Purchasing website. Five responses were received and evaluated according to the criteria listed in the RFP including: overall responsiveness and understanding to the RFP requirements, experience and ability, overall cost, references, financials, clarification, exception, deviation and credentials, resumes, licenses, and certifications. The evaluation committee was made up of representatives from the Probation Department and County Purchasing. All bidders are being recommended for an award to provide service to each of the YAT teams according to the sites that were identified in their RFP response. The maximum compensation rate is \$34.00 per hour for each vendor.

REVIEW/APPROVAL: County Purchasing and County Counsel concur with this request.
