**SUBJECT:** Approval of Contracts with Mental Health Systems, Inc. (MHS) and Family Services Association of Western Riverside County (FSAWRC) for Child Welfare Services Outcome Improvement Program.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors ratifies and:

- 1) Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreements with Mental Health Systems, Inc. (MHS) and Family Services Association of Western Riverside County (FSAWRC) to provide child abuse prevention and treatment services for Fiscal Year 2008-2009, with options to renew through Fiscal Year 2010-2011, with a total annual aggregate amount not to exceed \$459,948, funded by the Child Welfare Services Outcome Improvement Program (CWSOIP);
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign any future Amendments to the Agreements and to exercise renewal options on behalf of the Board, not to exceed the aggregate maximum annual amount of \$459,948; and
- 3) Authorizes the Director of the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to administer the Agreements, sign assurances, exhibits, and reports under the Agreements.

**BACKGROUND:**

On October 2, 2007 (Agenda #3.48), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors received and filed the 2007 Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County (PCARC) Needs Assessment for Riverside County. Based on the Needs Assessment, RFPs were formulated for release in a collaboration process between Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County (PCARC), DPSS and County Purchasing. Six RFP's were approved by the Board on November 27, 2007 (Agenda #3.17) to obtain child abuse prevention and treatment service for Fiscal Years 2008-2009 through 2010-2011 and released by County Purchasing and Fleet Services on December 3, 2007. Two of those RFPs provide for Family Preservation Court/Time Limited Reunification (FPC/TLR) and Differential Response (DR) services.

Past indicators have shown that the Family Preservation Court (FPC) (Drug Court) and Differential Response (DR) services are vital to proactively assist families and to ensure more positive outcomes for families, in or near crisis.

The attached agreements are:
