**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH**

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Men's Supportive Housing Program, operated through a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Mental Health and DPSS to provide permanent housing for men with mental illness. The Department of Mental Health's goal is to serve 10 men.

During FY 07/08, there were 10 single men participating in the housing program. During the course of the operating year, there were six (6) men who entered and exited the program, which allowed for the housing program to maintain a 100% capacity rate.

While the original project ended on January 31, 2008, there was a delay with HUD executing the attached renewal Grant Agreement. Due to HUD's late execution, this Agreement is being presented to the Board for approval retroactively to February 1, 2008.
