RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the resurfacing of various roads in the Butterfield Park, Temescal Canyon area. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, September 24, 2008, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the resurfacing of various streets in the Butterfield Park as listed on page two of this submittal as a base bid. Roadway resurfacing is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The adjustment to grade of utilities, owned by the Lee Lake Water District, is included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If the District approves the award of the alternate bid schedule as bid by
