RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of traffic signal and lighting at the intersection of Bundy Canyon Road and The Farm Road, Wildomar area. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 PM, Wednesday, September 24, 2008, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The proposed traffic signal will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements that are exiting from The Farm Road on to Bundy Canyon Road, which has

The signal operation and maintenance cost is estimated at \$5,000 per year and will be funded from Gas Tax until June 30, 2009 at which time the traffic signal maintenance will become the responsibility of the City of Wildomar unless they choose to continue contracting with the County for this service.

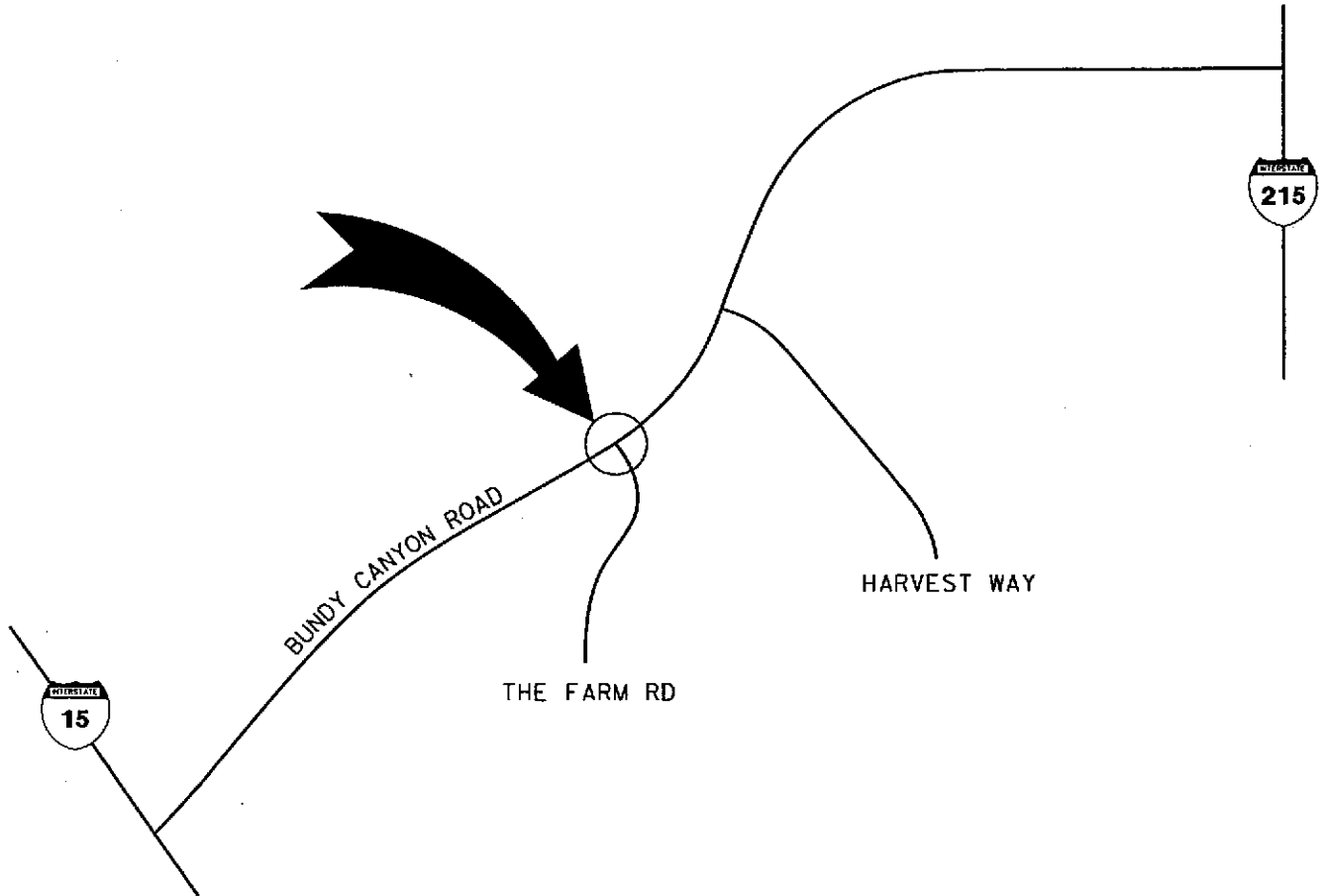
The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. *Environmental clearance is complete.*

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities. The Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program funds were granted through a statewide safety program in which the County successfully competed.
