SUBJECT: Amendment No. 2 to the Maintenance Agreement between the County of Riverside and the City of Moreno Valley for Pigeon Pass Road, that fronts the Box Springs Mountain Reserve, between Cougar Canyon Drive and Hidden Springs Drive.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and execute the amended agreement documents for service and maintenance of that portion of Pigeon Pass Road, from approximately 600 feet north of Cougar Canyon Drive to Hidden Springs Drive.

BACKGROUND: The City of Moreno Valley seeks to amend the Maintenance Agreement between the County and the City for roads that are on the City/County boundary. The City will widen Pigeon Pass Road, between Climbing Rose Drive and the north City limit, to its ultimate width in accordance with the City's General Plan. As part of the overall agreement, the City

agrees to maintain the portion of Pigeon Pass Road that fronts the Box Springs Mountain Reserve (unincorporated lands), including the intersection of Pigeon Pass Road and Hidden Springs Drive. Due to the remote location of the project relative to other County maintained roads, the County has agreed to have the City accept full maintenance responsibility of the road in lieu of having the City take over the road easement adjacent to the Box Springs Mountain Reserve.

The rest of the original 1994 Maintenance Agreement, first amended in 2006, will stay the same.
