SUBJECT: Purchase of One (1) Landfill Compactor from other than Low Bidder

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors receive and file notice of the purchase of one (1) 2009 Caterpillar (CAT) Model 836H Landfill Compactor to other than the low bidder at an additional cost of \$19,415.47.

BACKGROUND: The Purchasing Department issued a formal Request for Quotation (RFQ) for a new 2009 landfill compactor on behalf of the Waste Management Department (WMD). A statement informing bidders of the local vendor preference policy was included in the bid instructions. Copies of the RFQ were sent to four bidders and four bid responses were received ranging from \$734,845 to \$1,027,443 with the two lowest bids considered non responsive. The overall low responsive and responsible bidder was AL-Jon Manufacturing, LLC (Ottumwa, Iowa) at a total cost of \$1,008,029. The low responsive and responsible Riverside County local vendor bid was from Johnson Machinery whose bid was \$1,027,444. (Continued)

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

In October 1995, the Board of Supervisors approved a local vendor preference program adding 5% to a non-local vendor when comparing bids in order to give a reasonable preference to local vendors. Applying the percentage to the Al-Jon bid adds more than \$50,000. The original bids were less than \$20,000 (1.9%) apart. In keeping with the local preference guidelines WMD will be awarding the bid to Johnson Machinery.
