SUBJECT: Contract Agreement with City of Palm Springs for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Program Services

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Approve the attached Agreement between the City of Palm Springs (City) and the Waste Management Department (Department); and
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Department.

BACKGROUND: Since 1995, the County and the City have partnered to provide Anti-Freeze, Batteries, Oil and Latex Paint (ABOP) collection services to the residents of the Coachella Valley through the County's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Program on City-owned land at the Palm Springs Fire Training Center. The attached Agreement continues the existing arrangement for HHW collection services while also planning to relocate the facility to a larger City-owned site, upgrading it from an ABOP-only to a permanent HHW facility, in order to accept electronic waste and all other types of commonly collected HHW. 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The City will build the new facility near the City's waste water treatment plant and the Department will operate the facility.

The Department secured a regional grant with the City from the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) to help offset the City's cost in constructing the new facility and to help offset the Department's cost to purchase equipment for the site. After the Department's equipment purchase, \$121,344 will be paid to the City after the City provides an itemized invoice to the Department detailing costs of construction. The Department will then seek grant reimbursement from the CIWMB for these itemized construction costs.

FINANCIAL: This agreement provides for partial funding of costs to relocate the Palm Springs HHW facility through regional grant funds that will be reimbursed to the Department by the CIWMB. The City will provide use of, and improvements to, the land for this facility. The equipment purchase and construction cost offset are included in the Department's annual budget.
